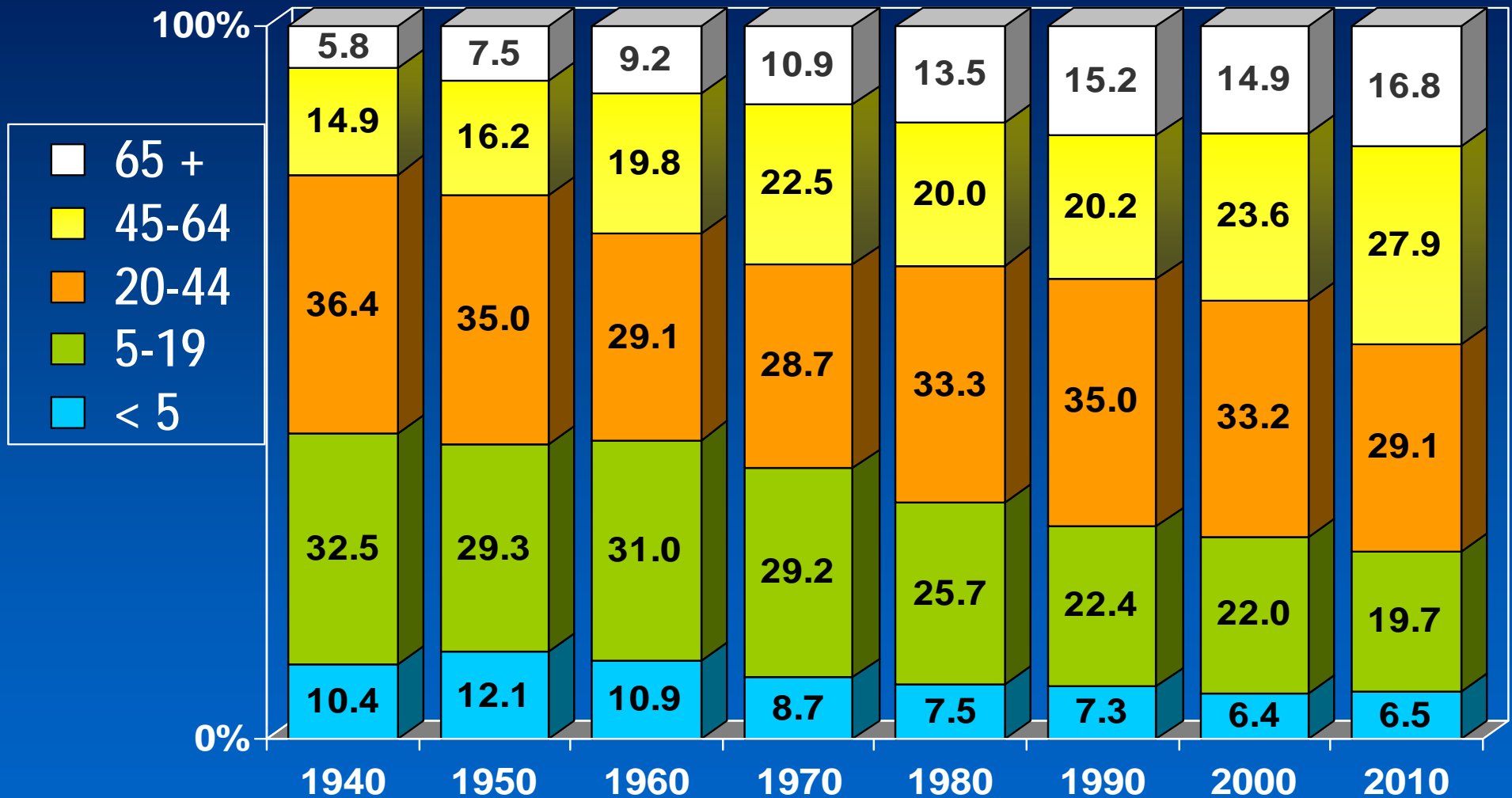

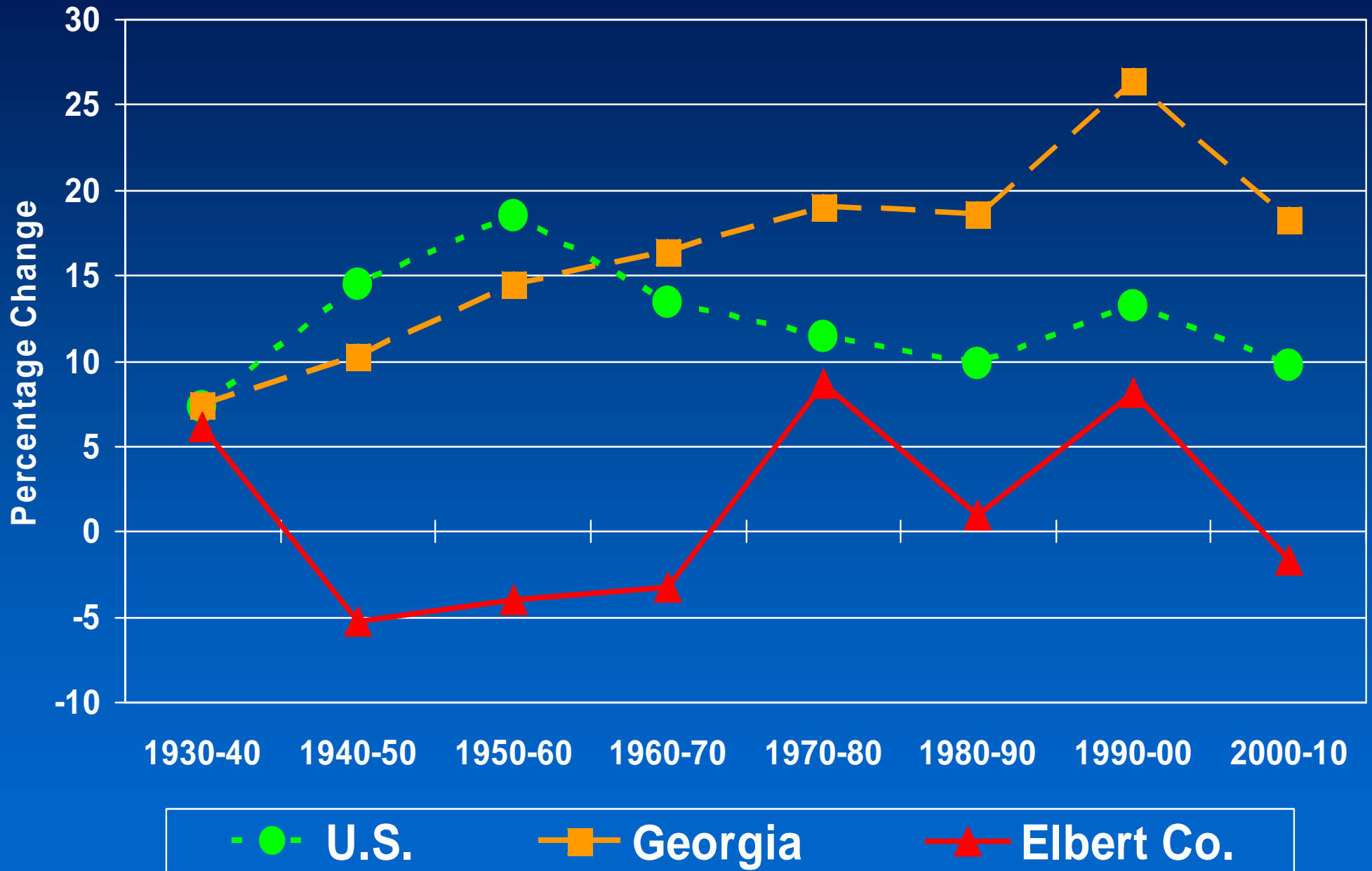

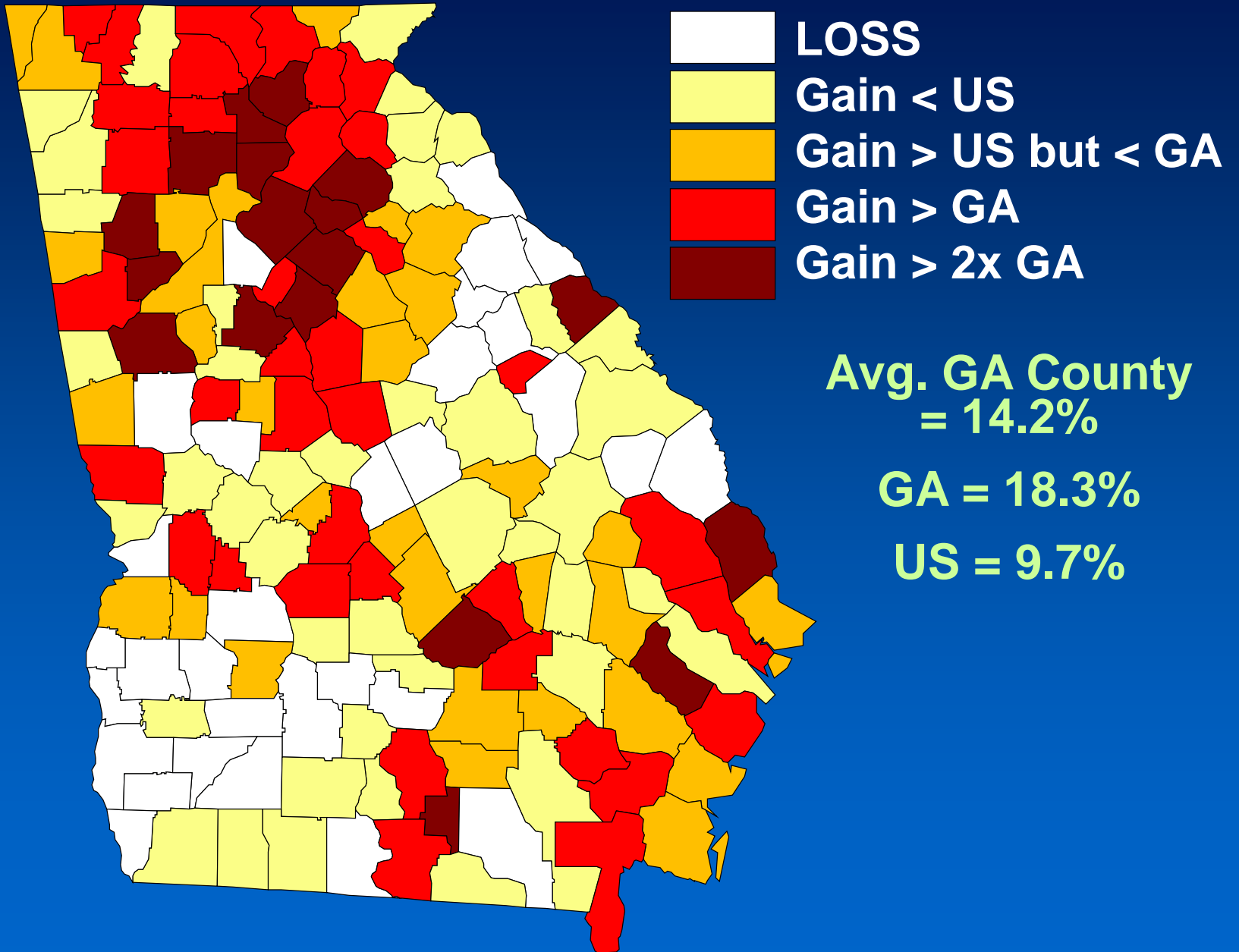

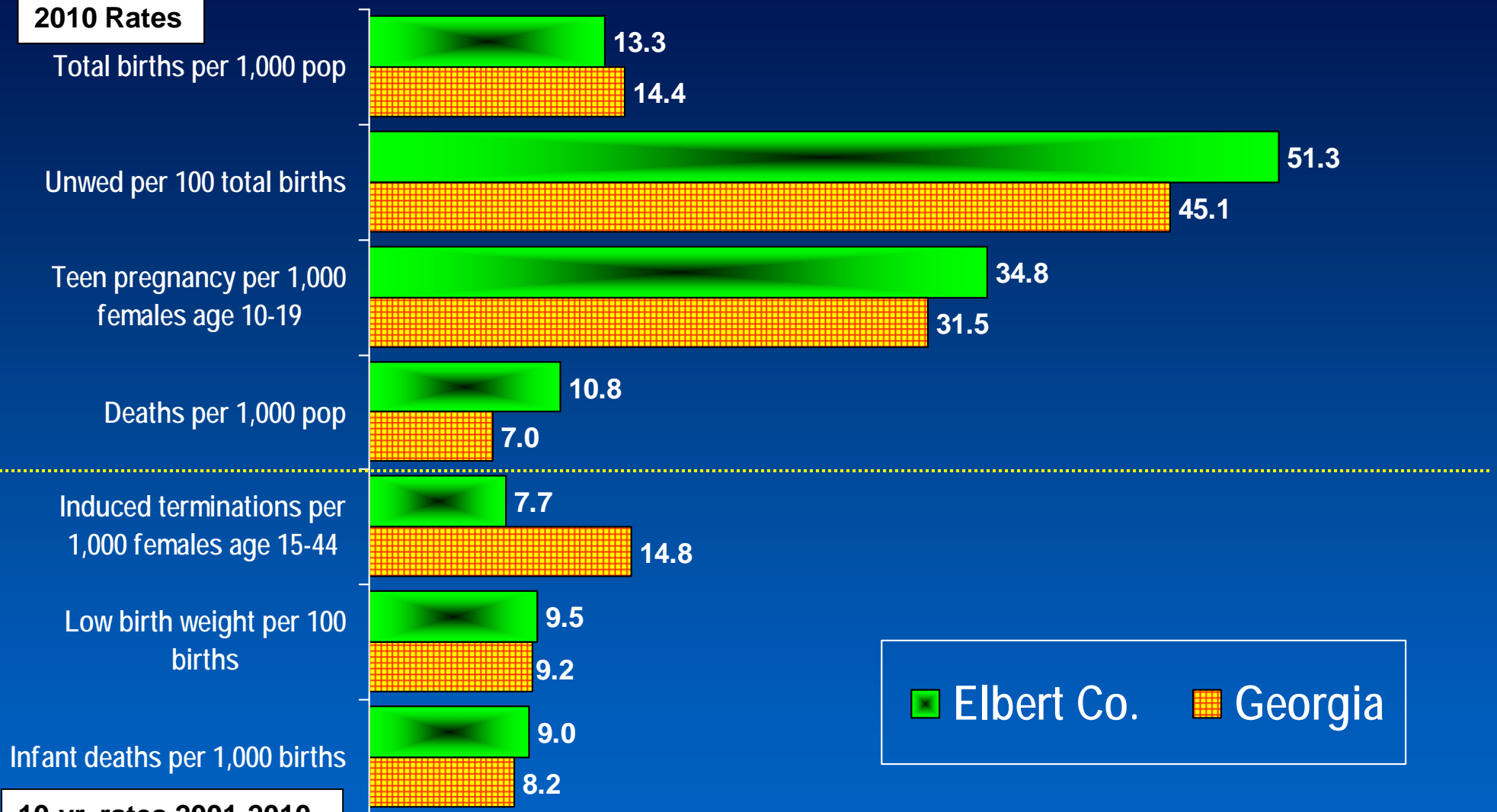

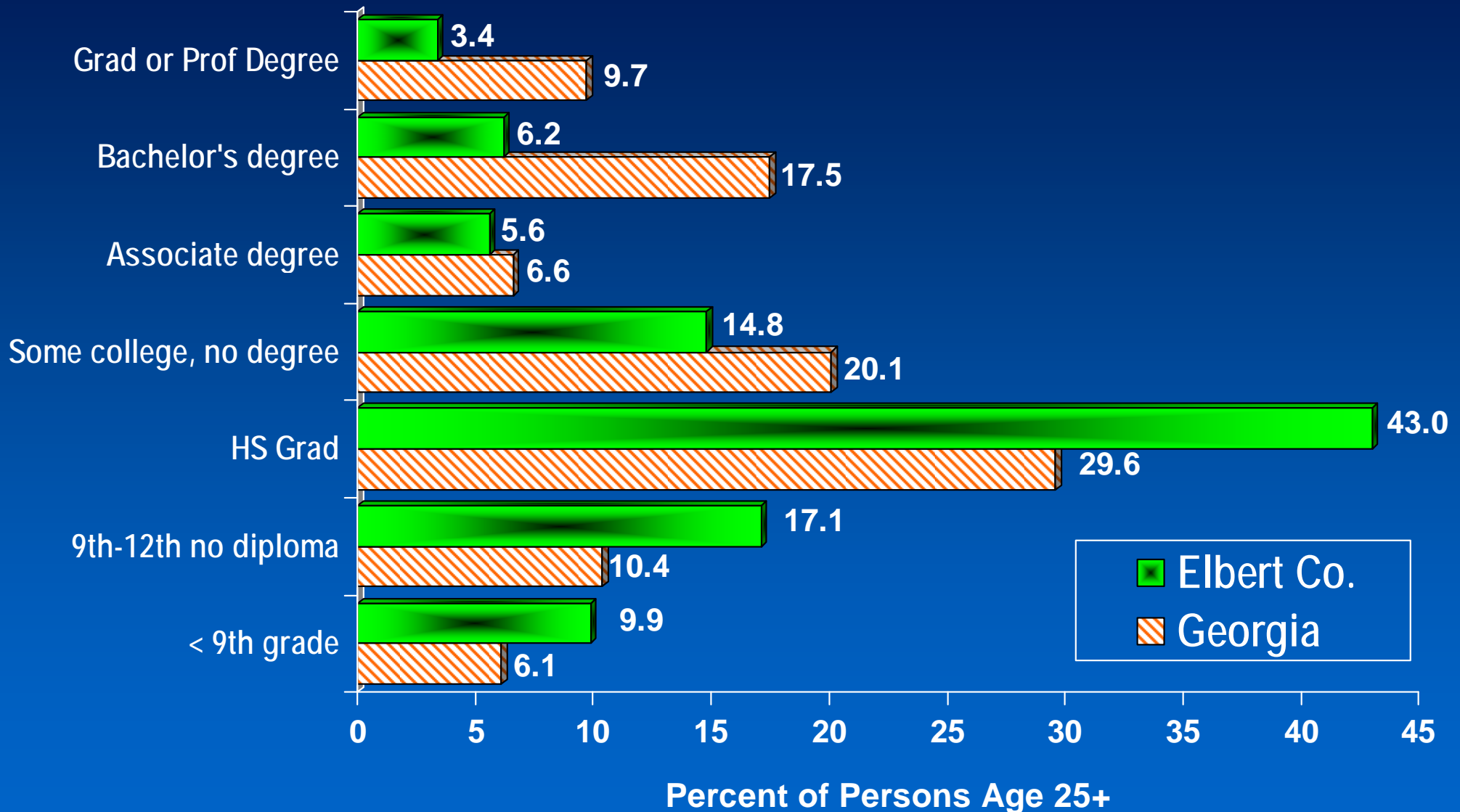

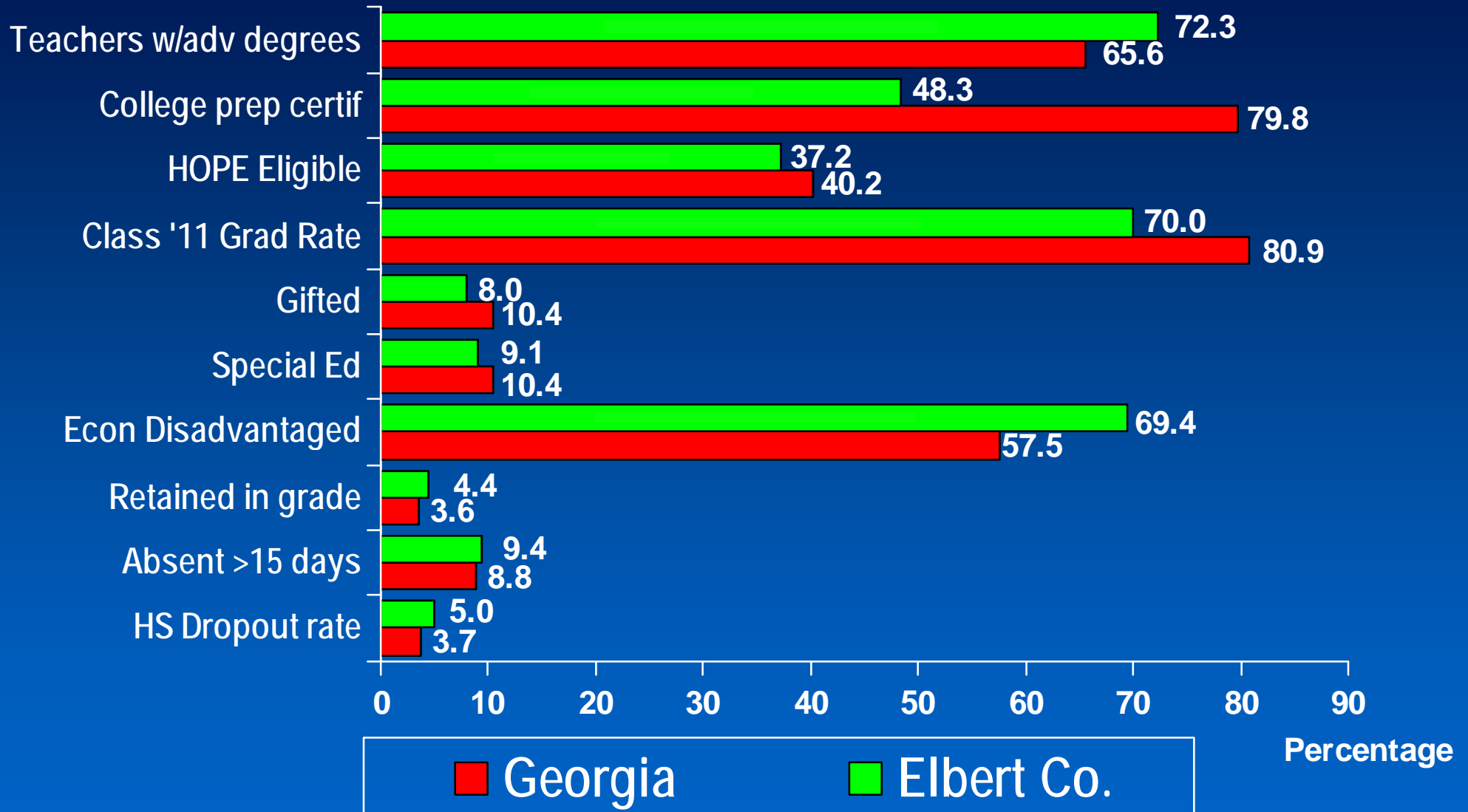

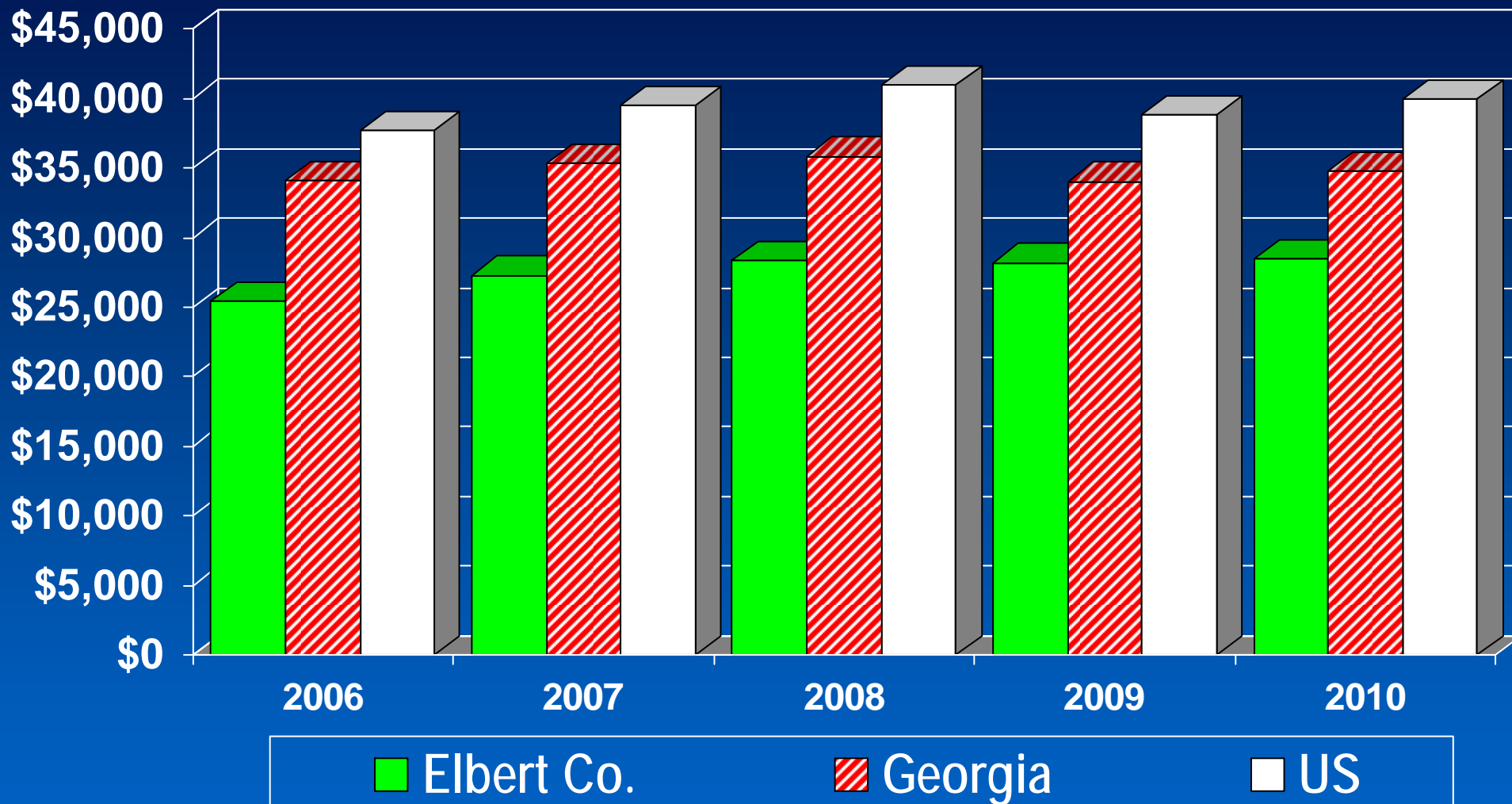

Per Capita Income: 2006-2010

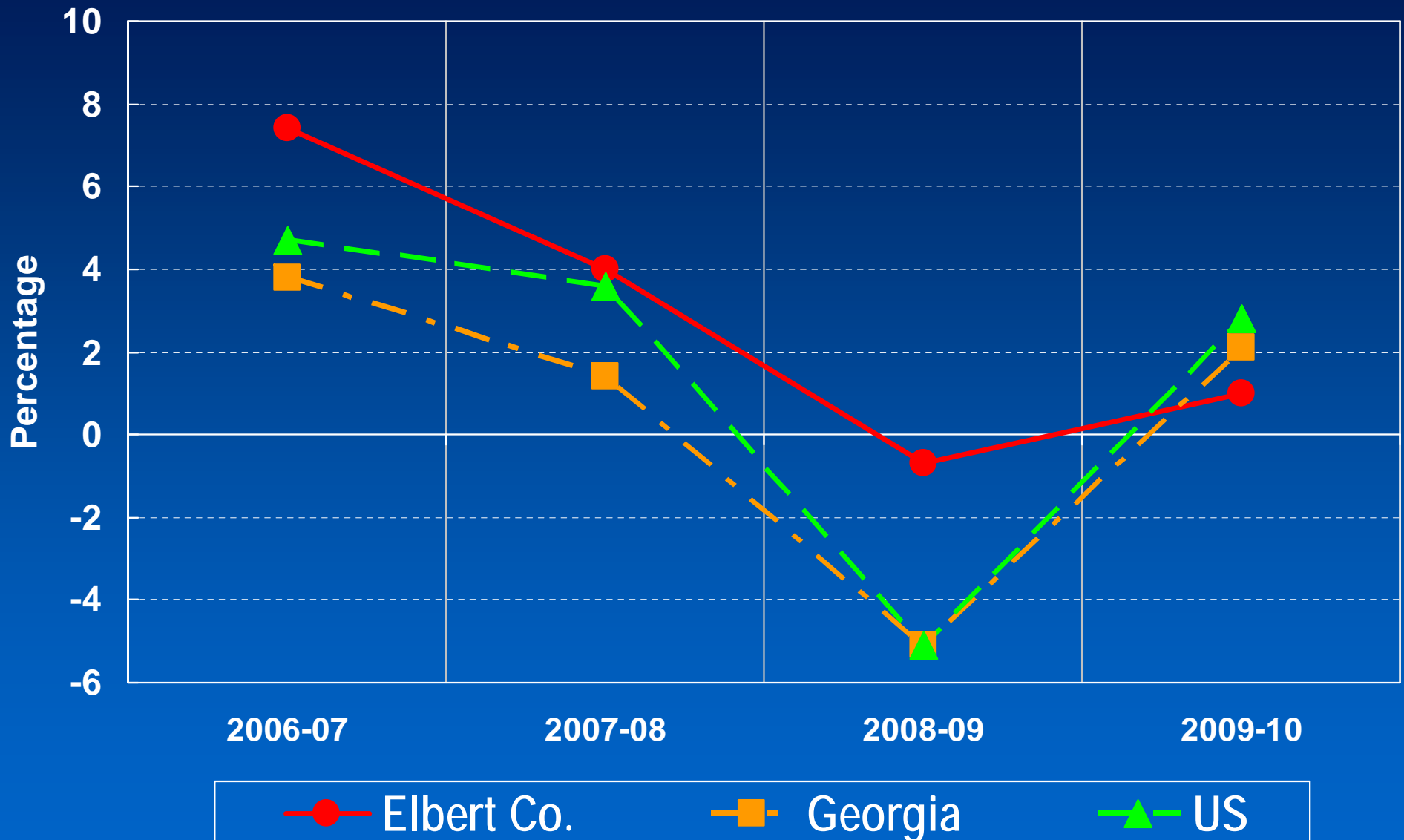

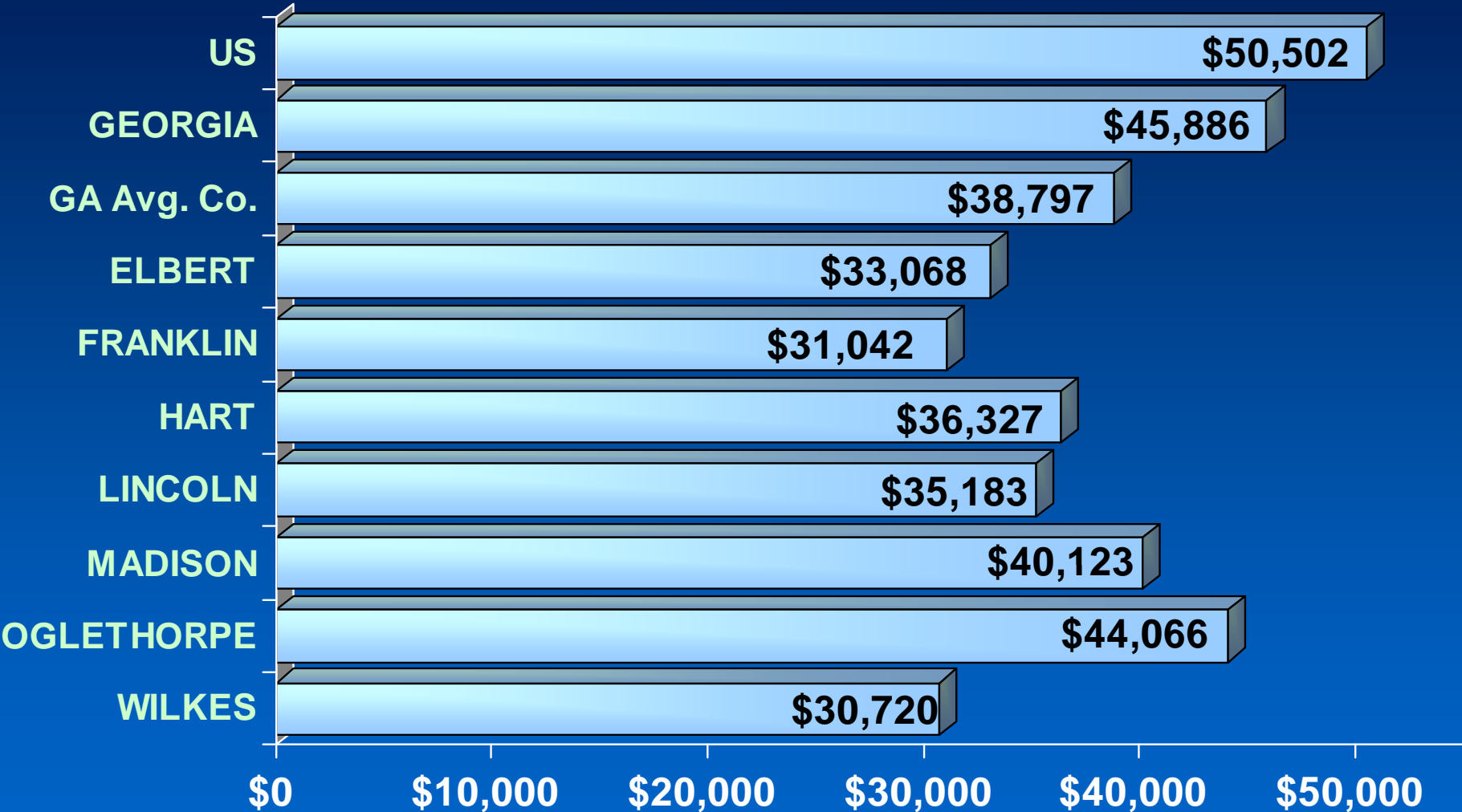

Median Household Income

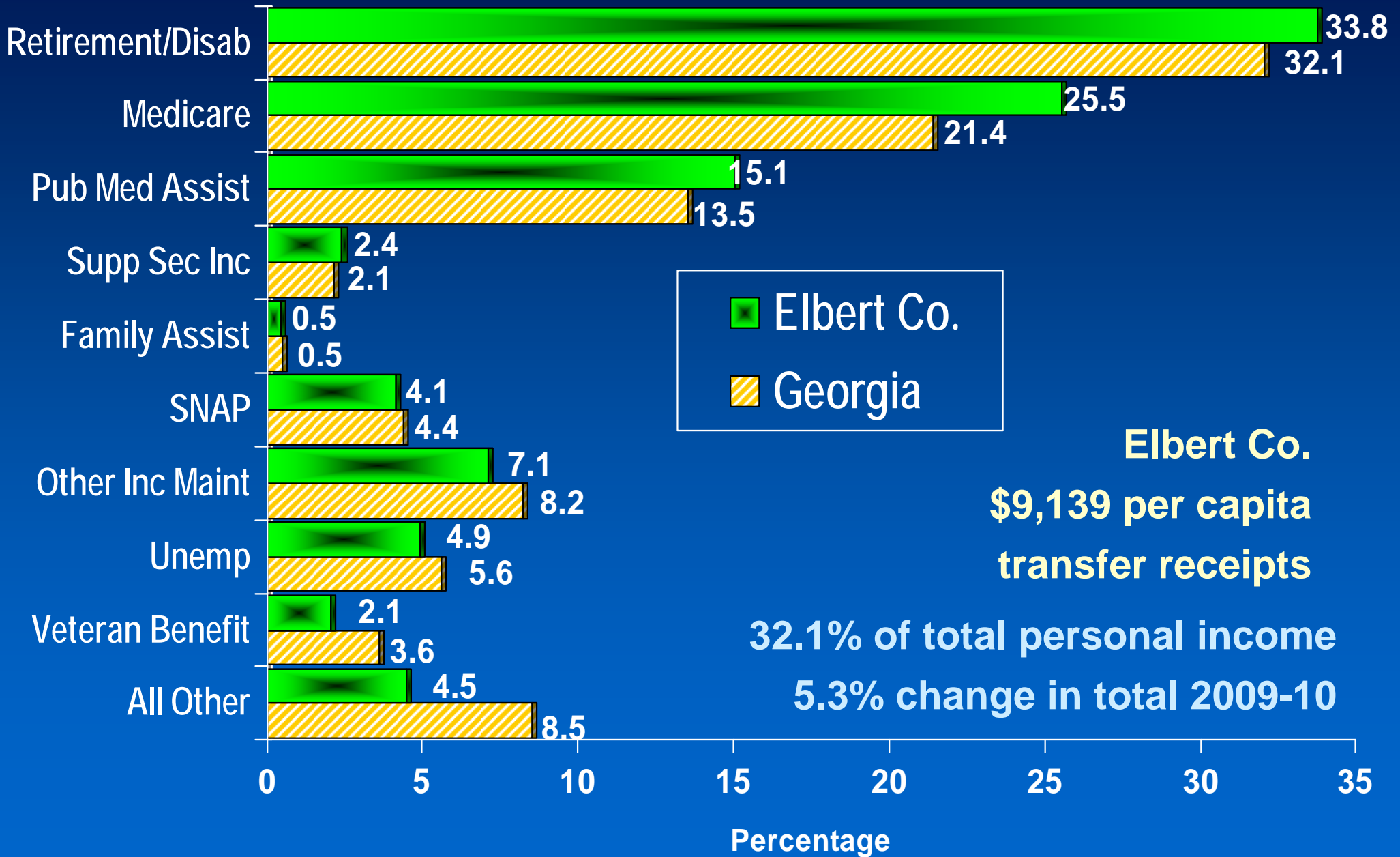

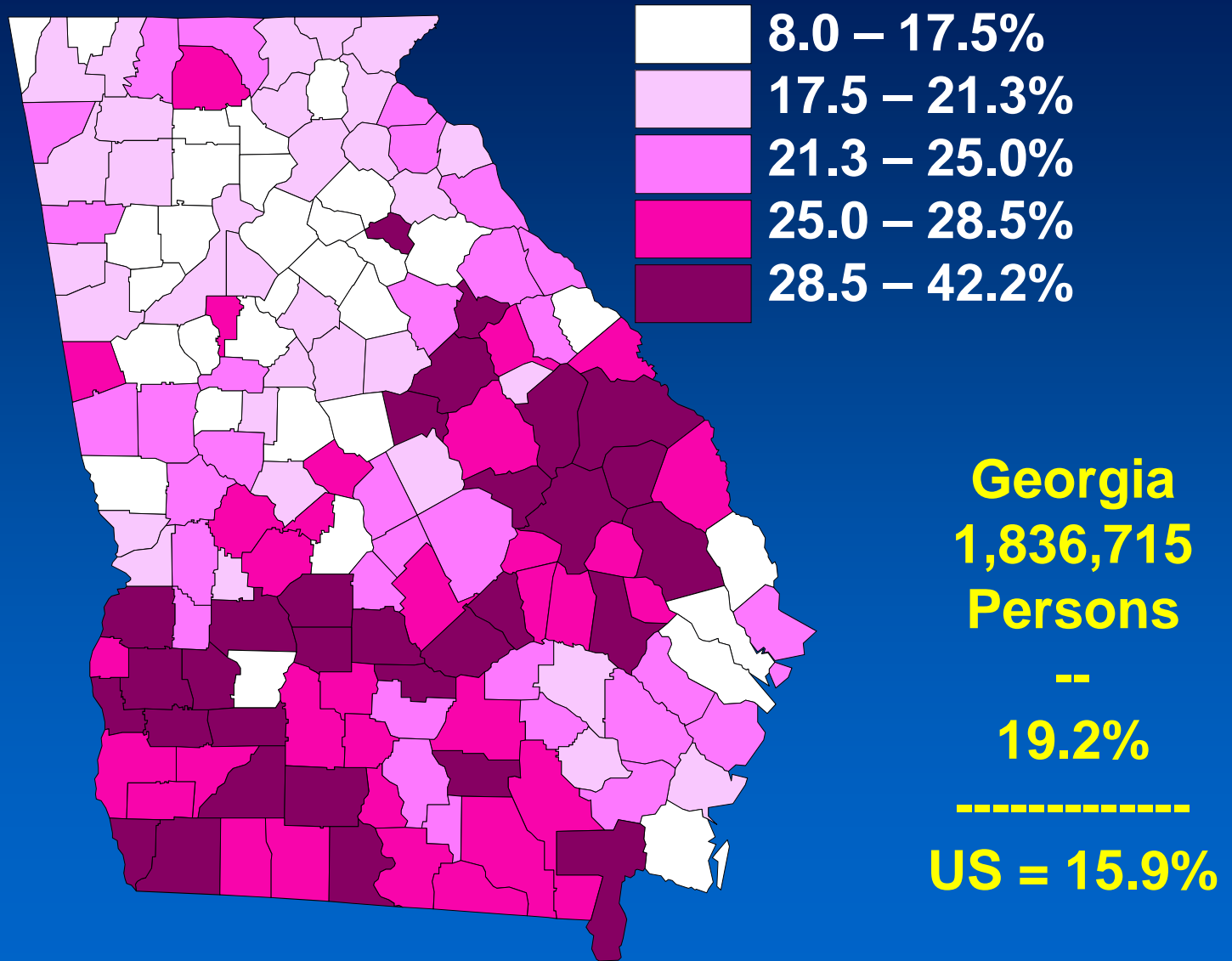

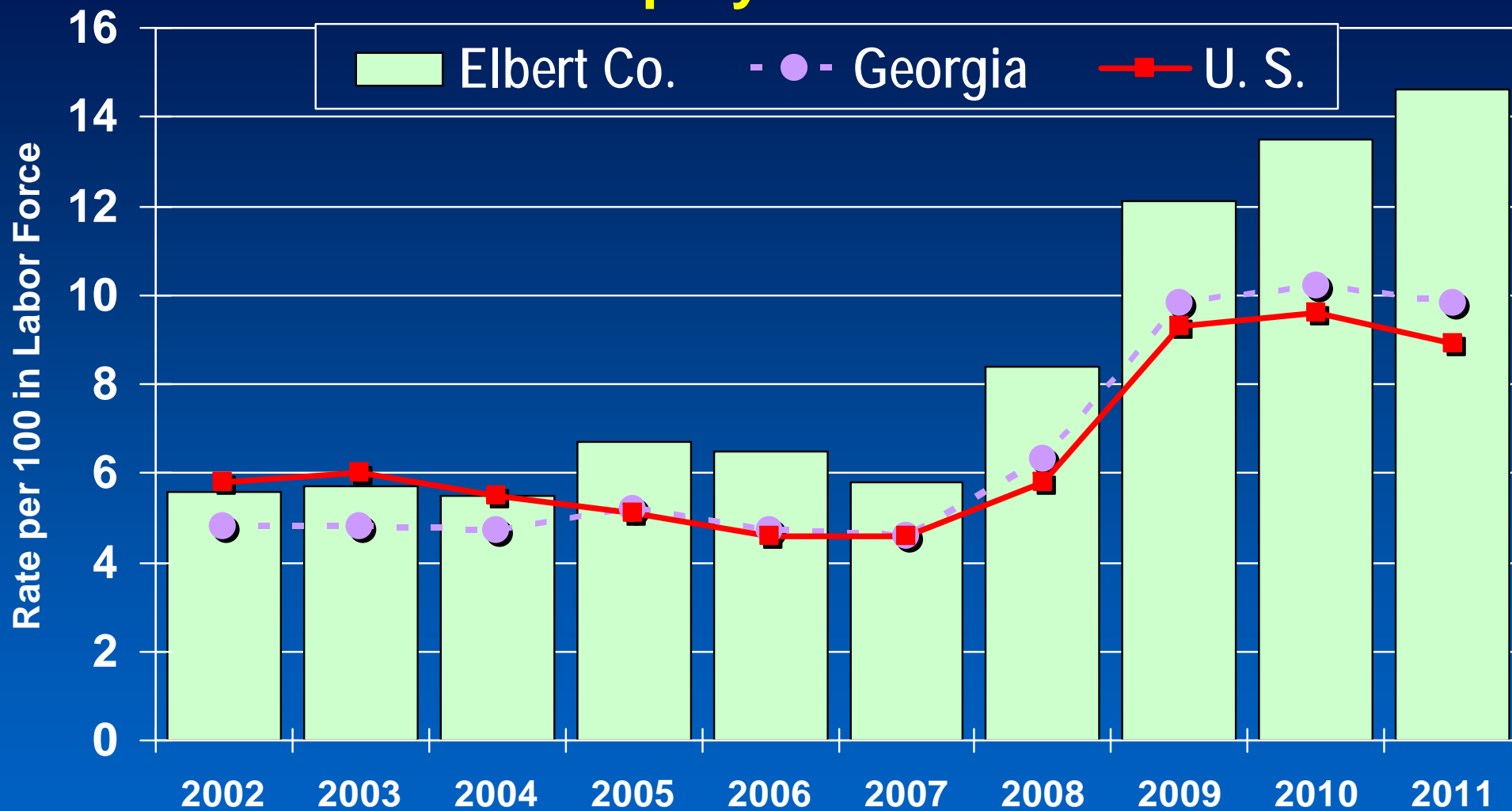

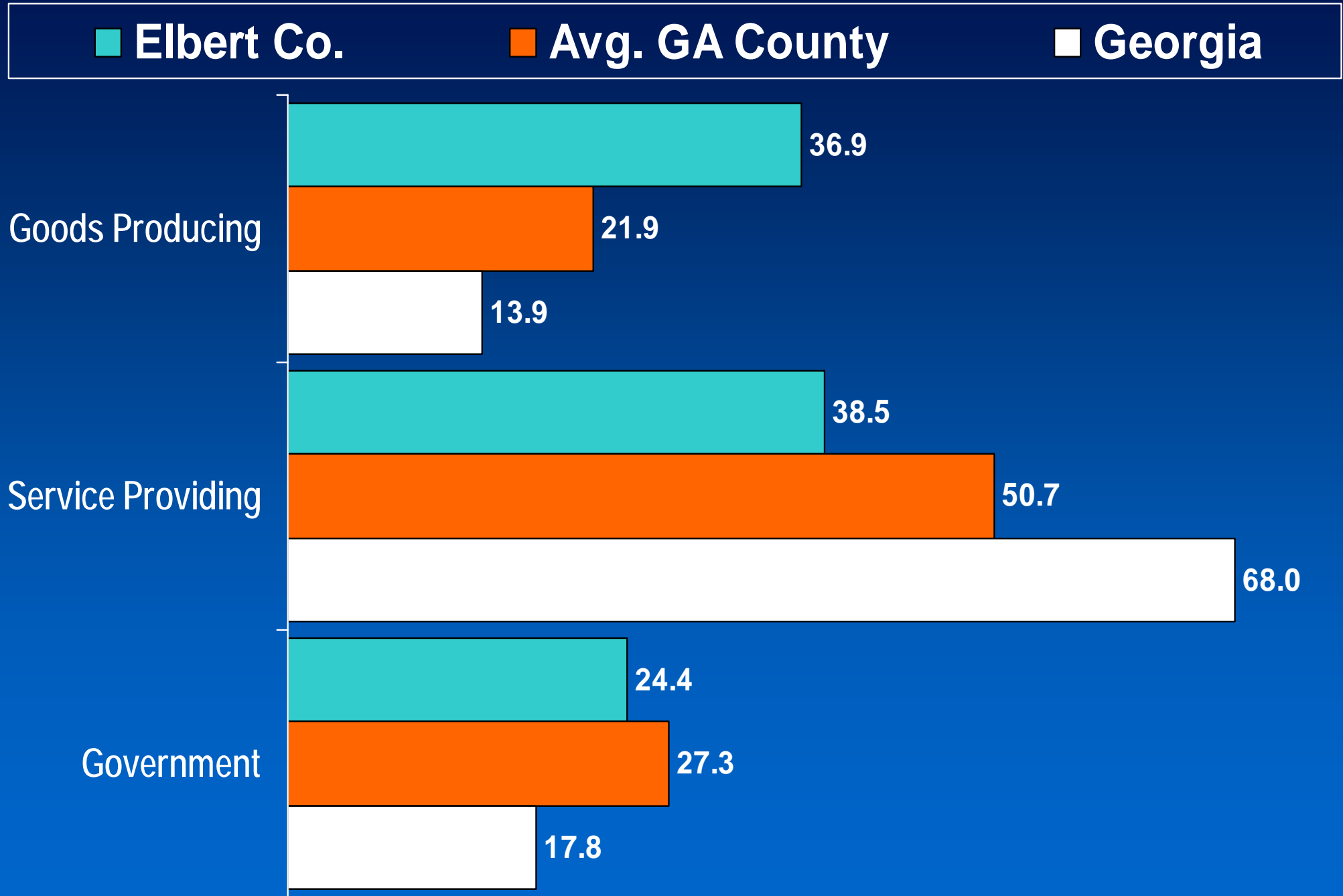

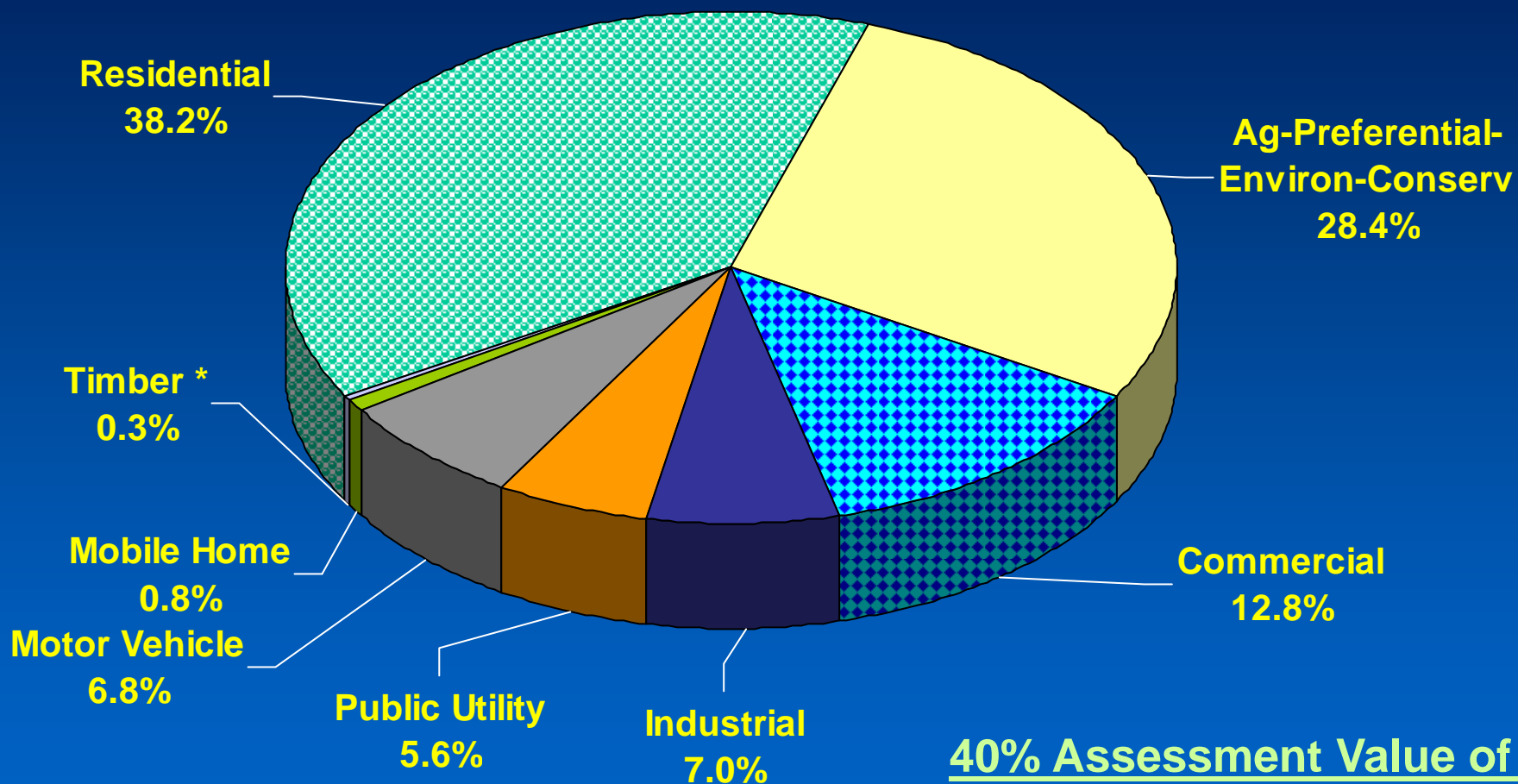

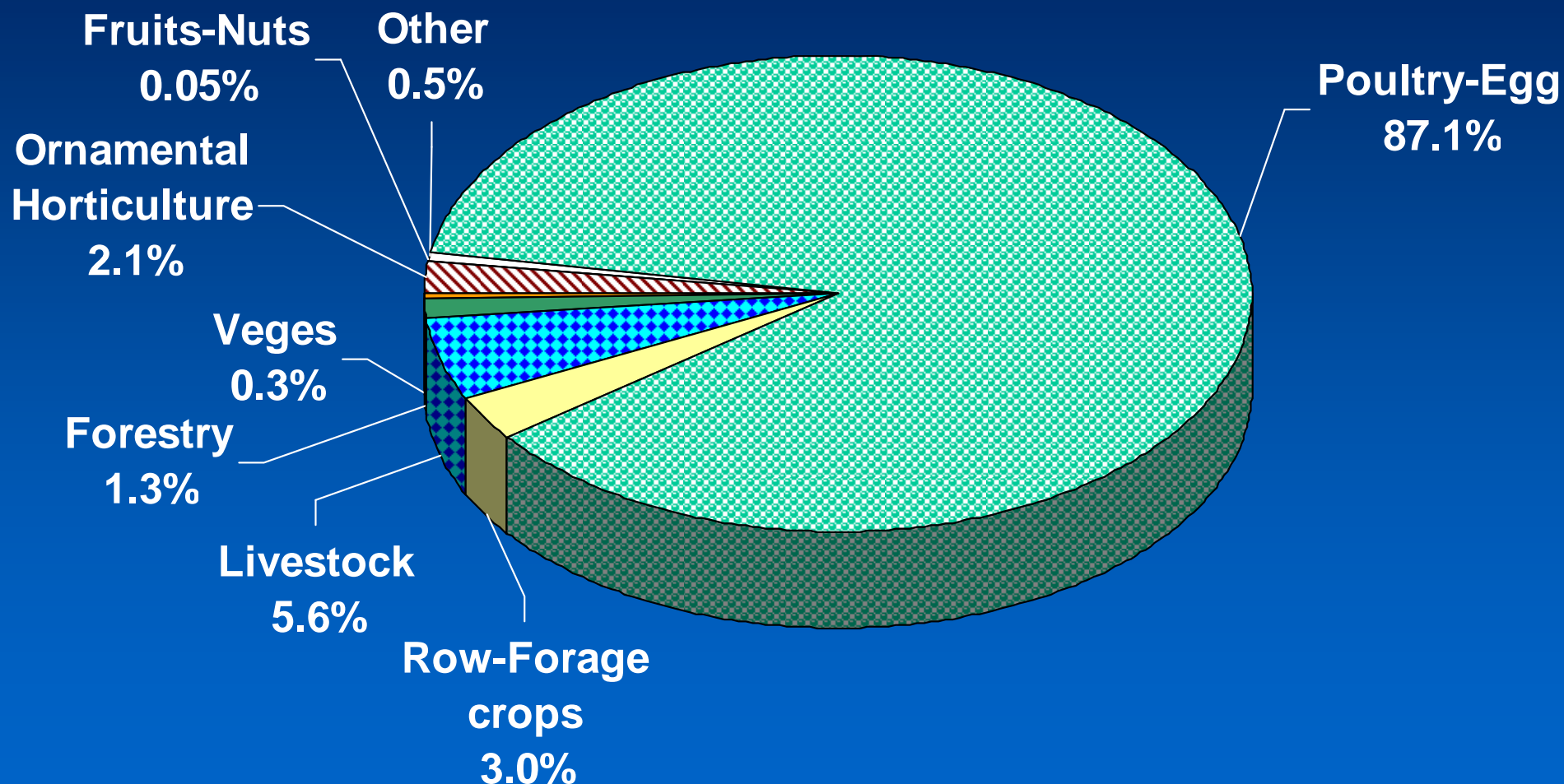

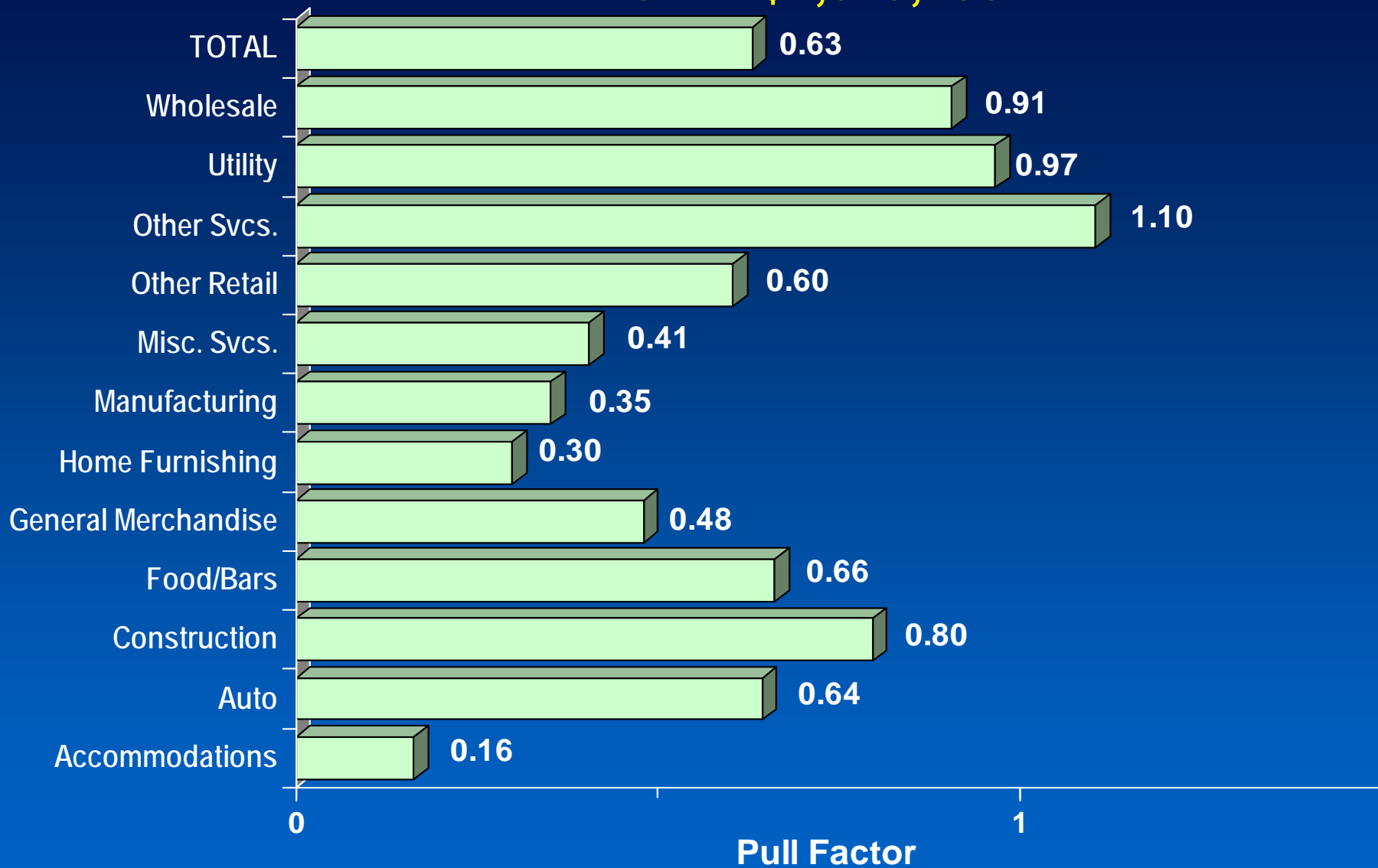
Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2011

Elbert Co. = \$2,029,286

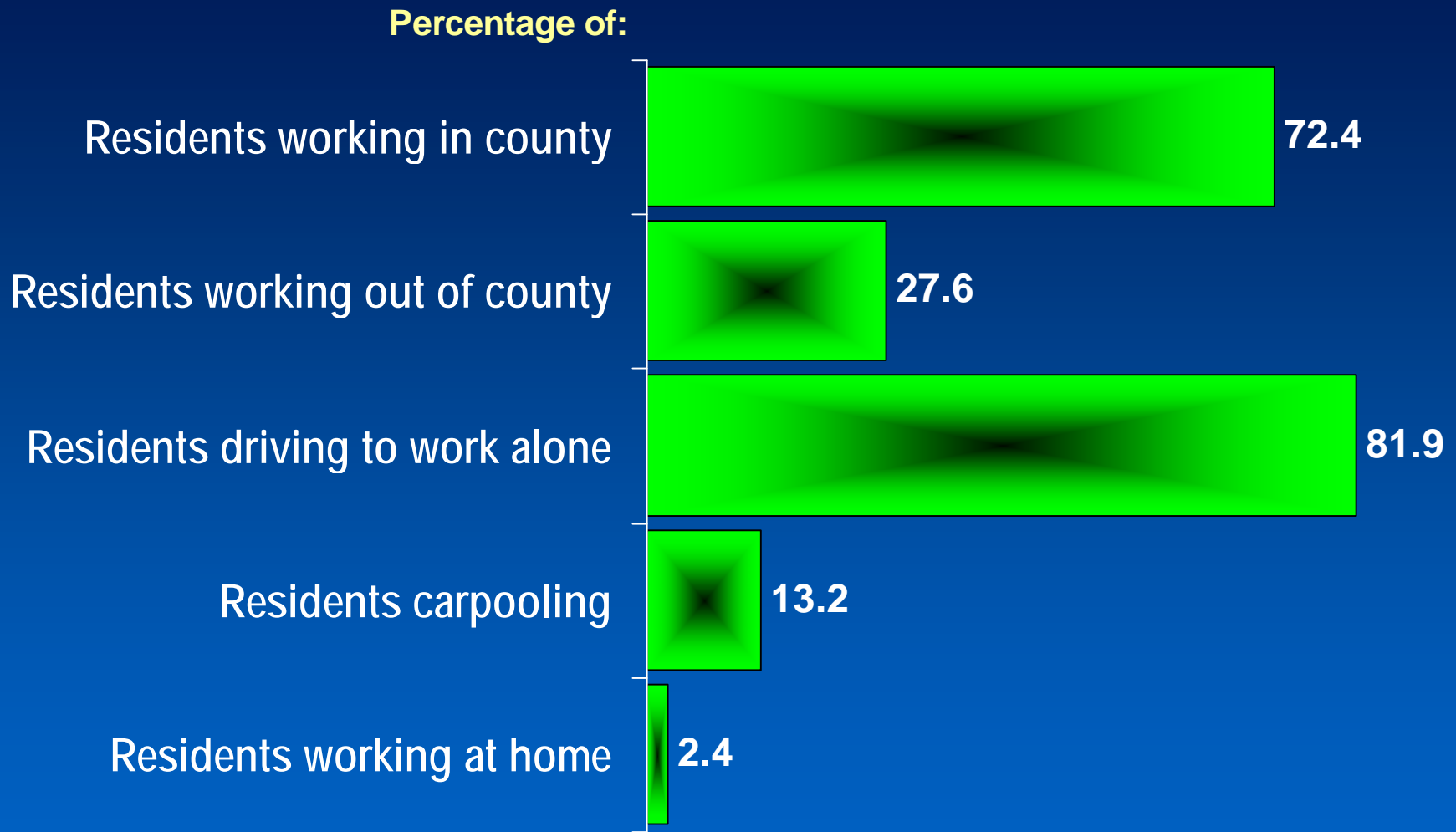


A "pull factor" of 1.0 means that the county's sales are what would be expected based upon the number of residents and their relative wealth.

Residents working out of county = 2,253

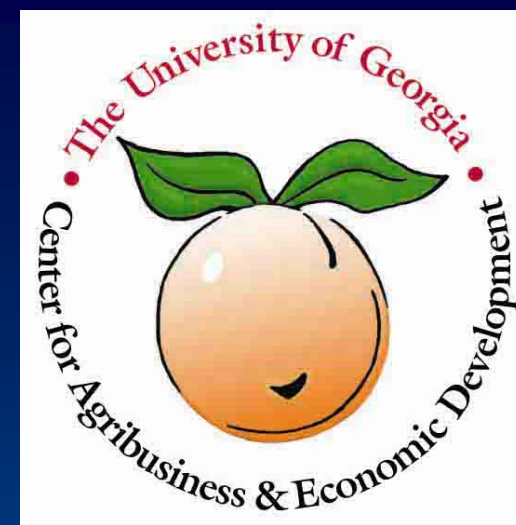
