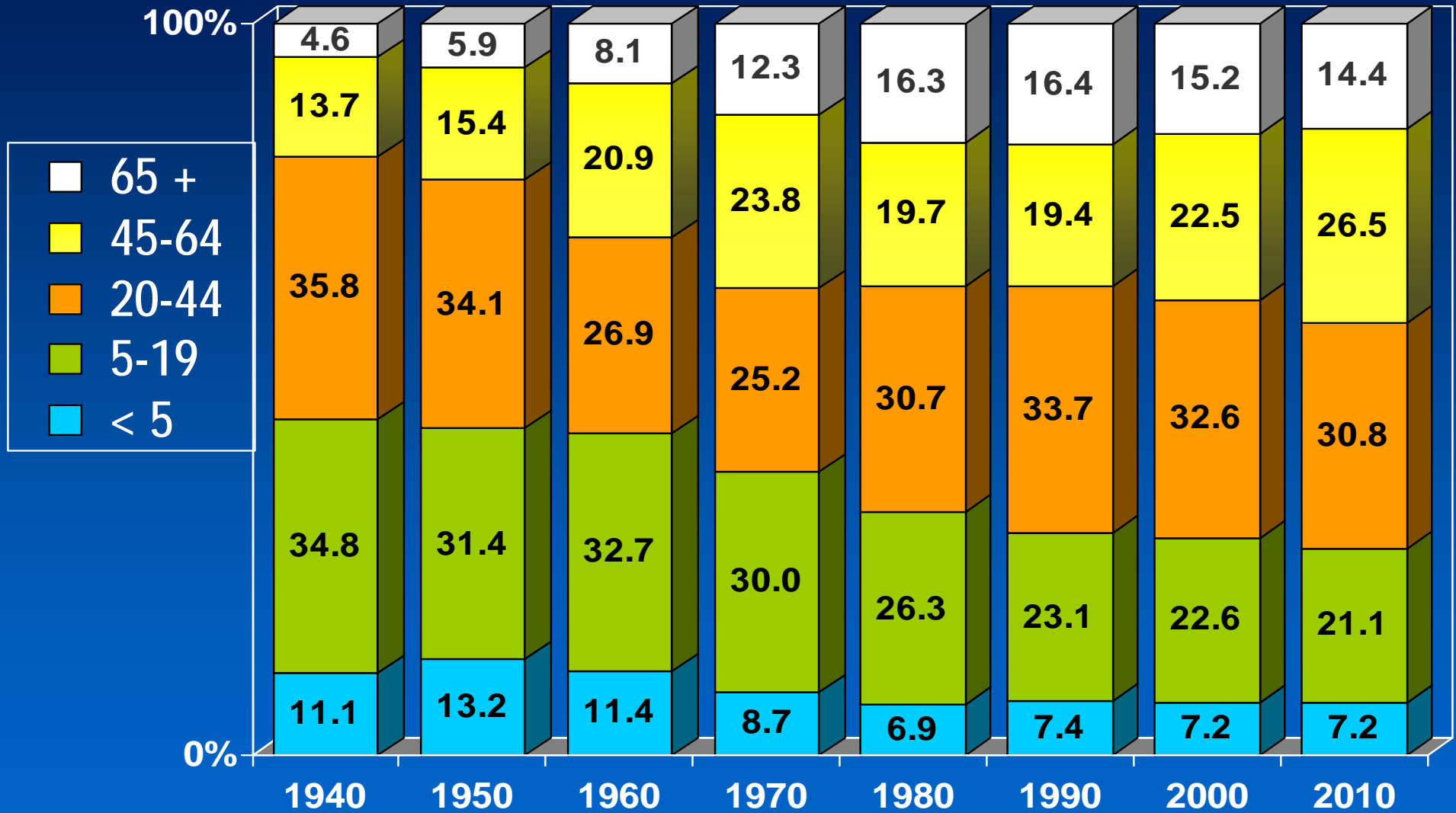

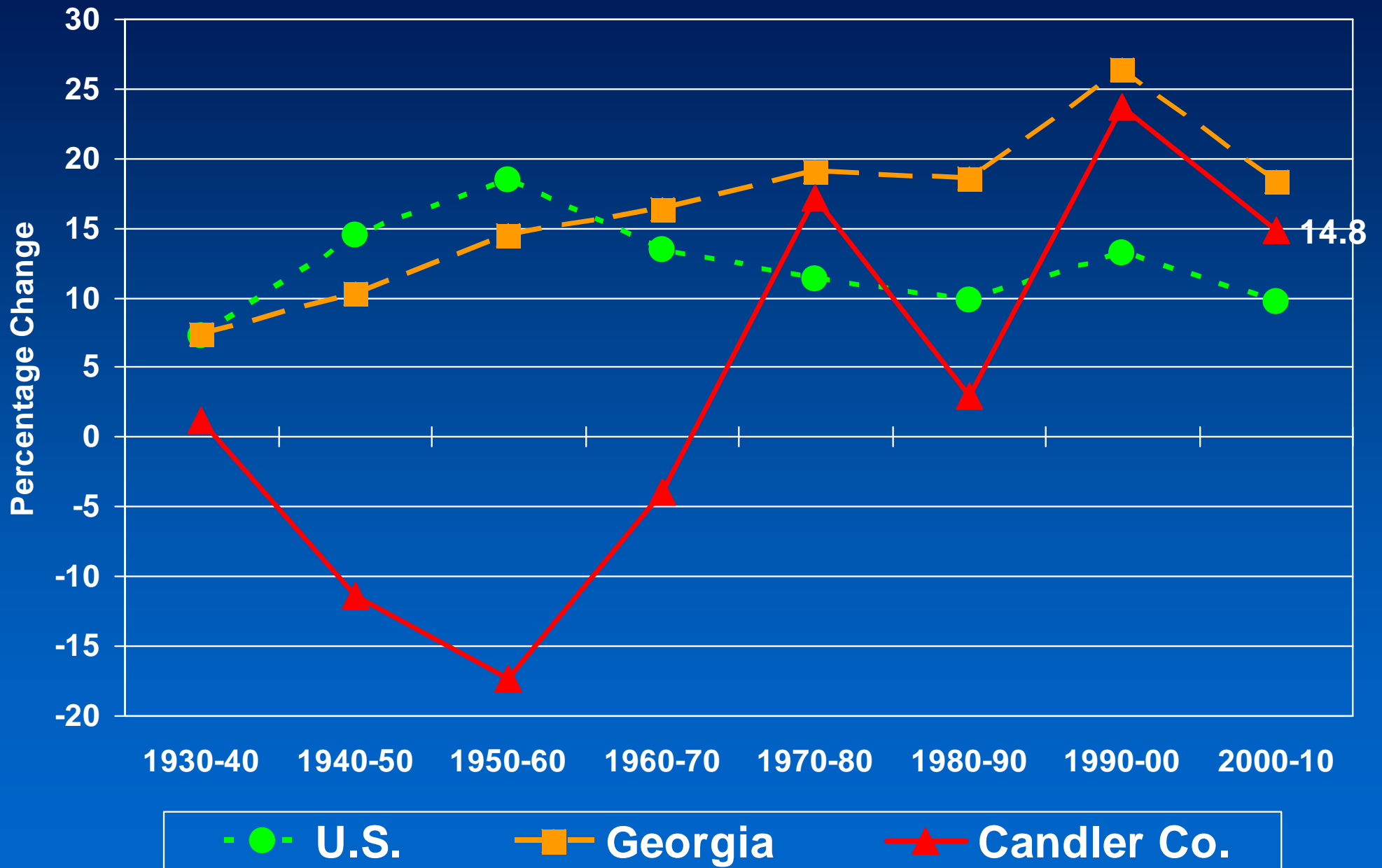

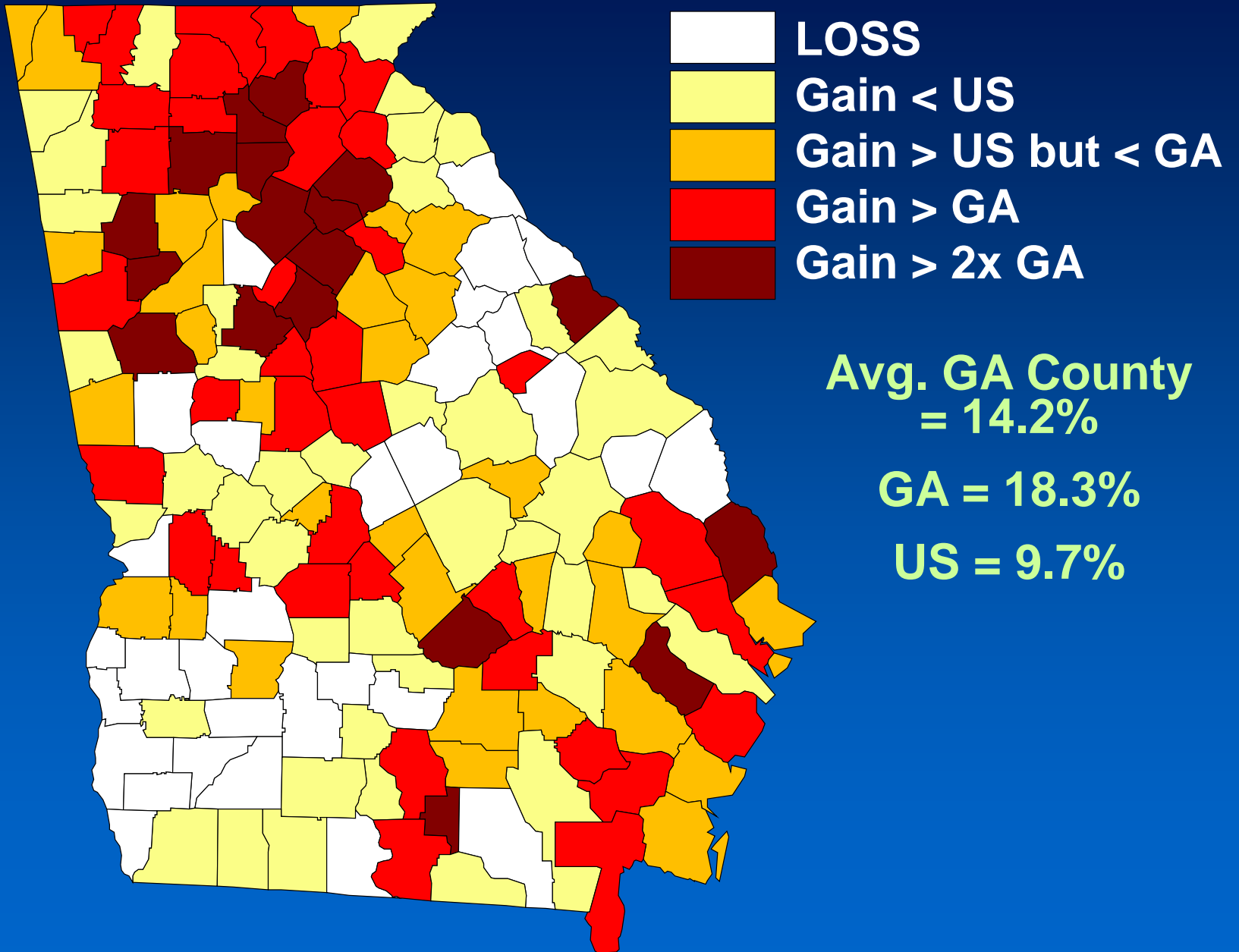

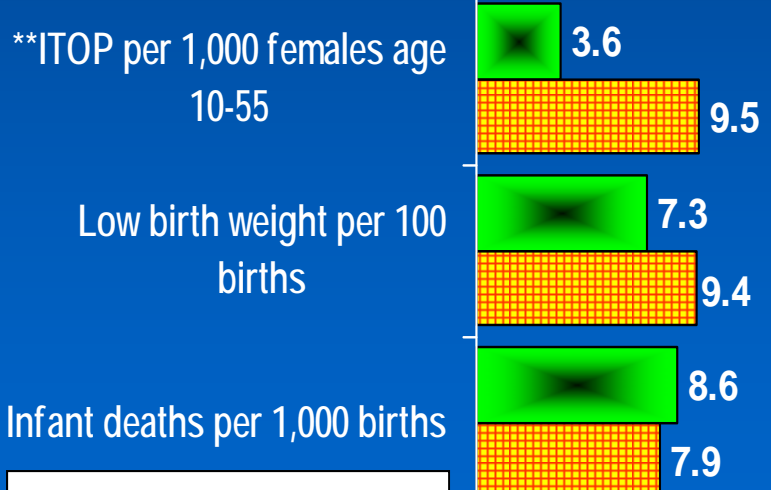

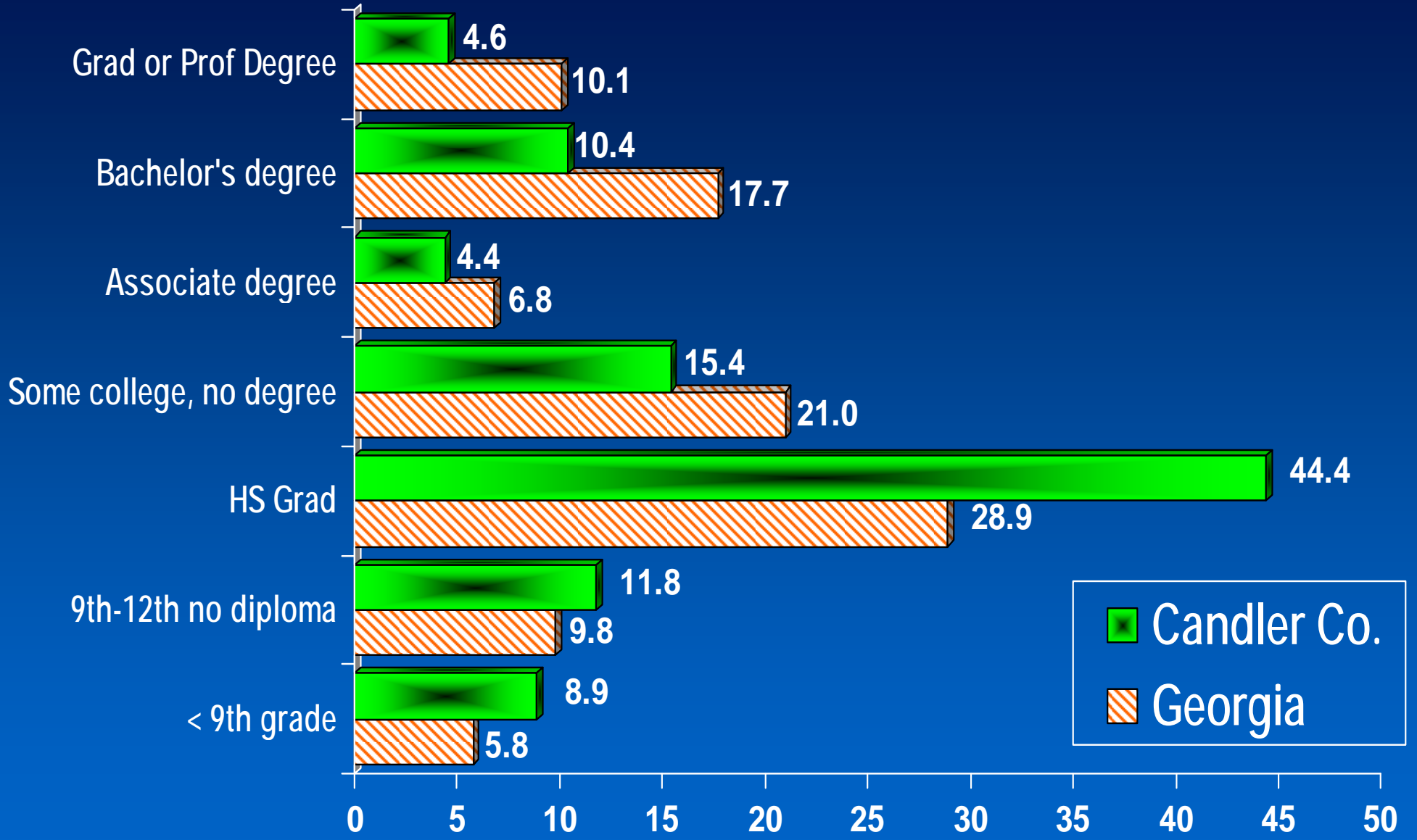

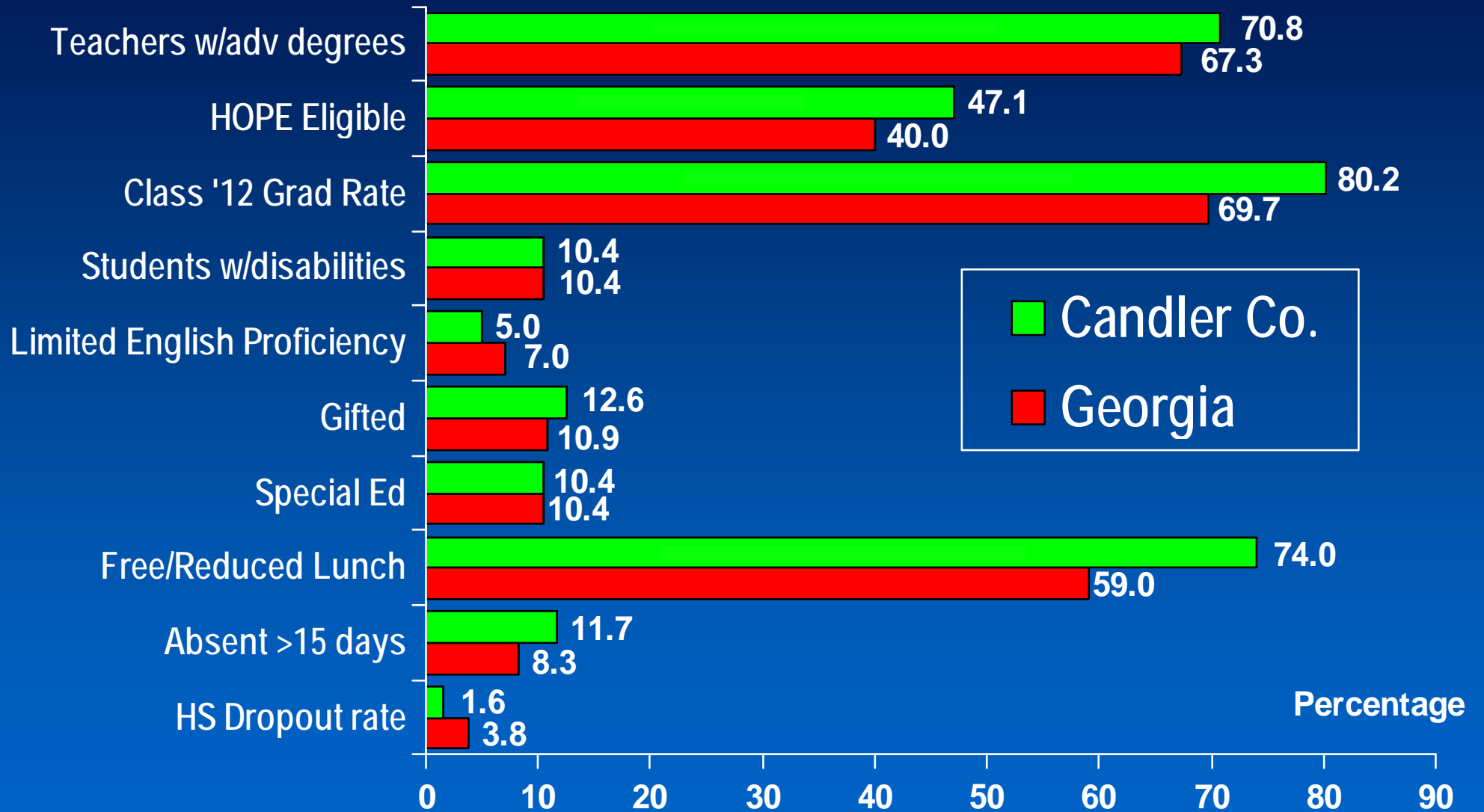

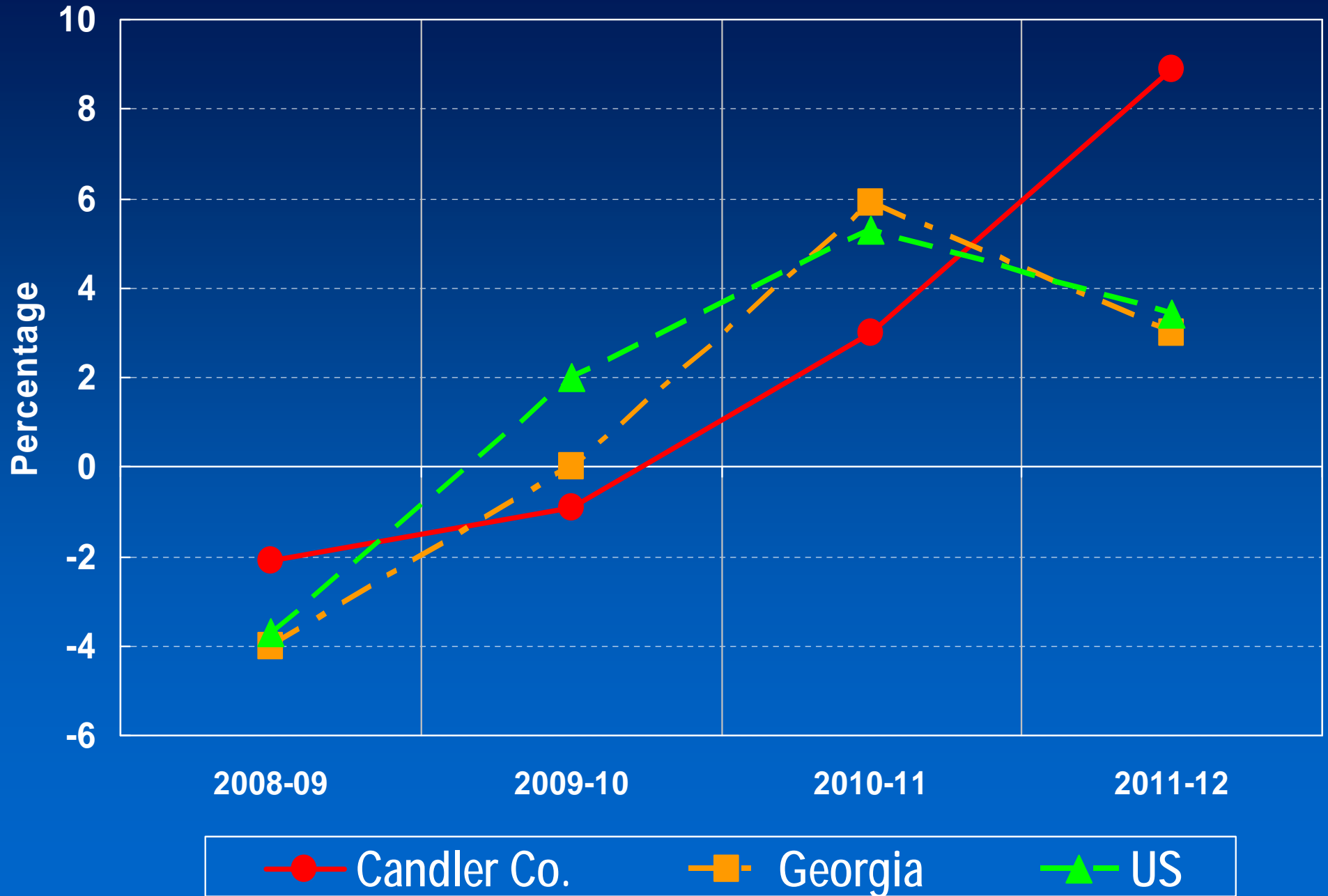

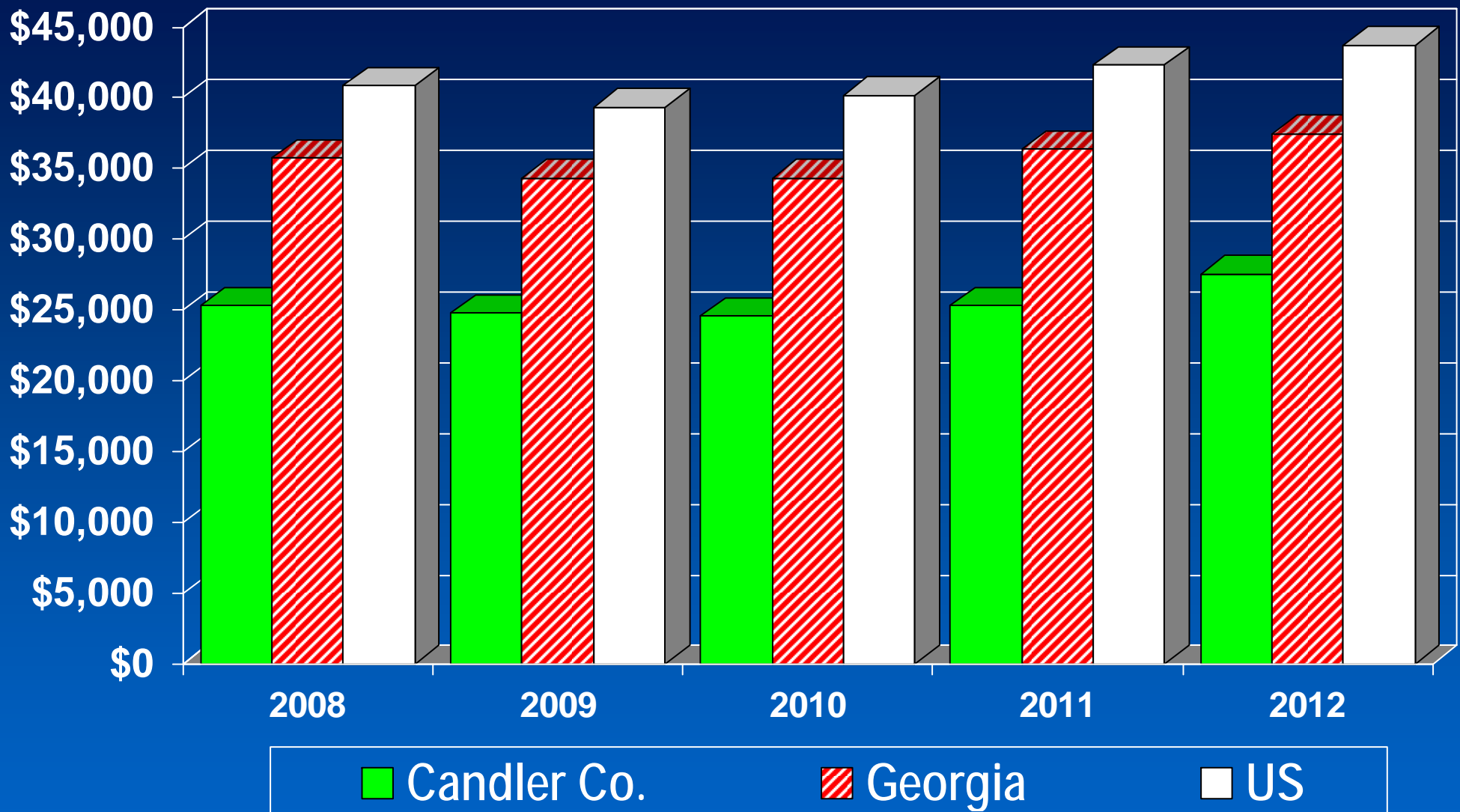

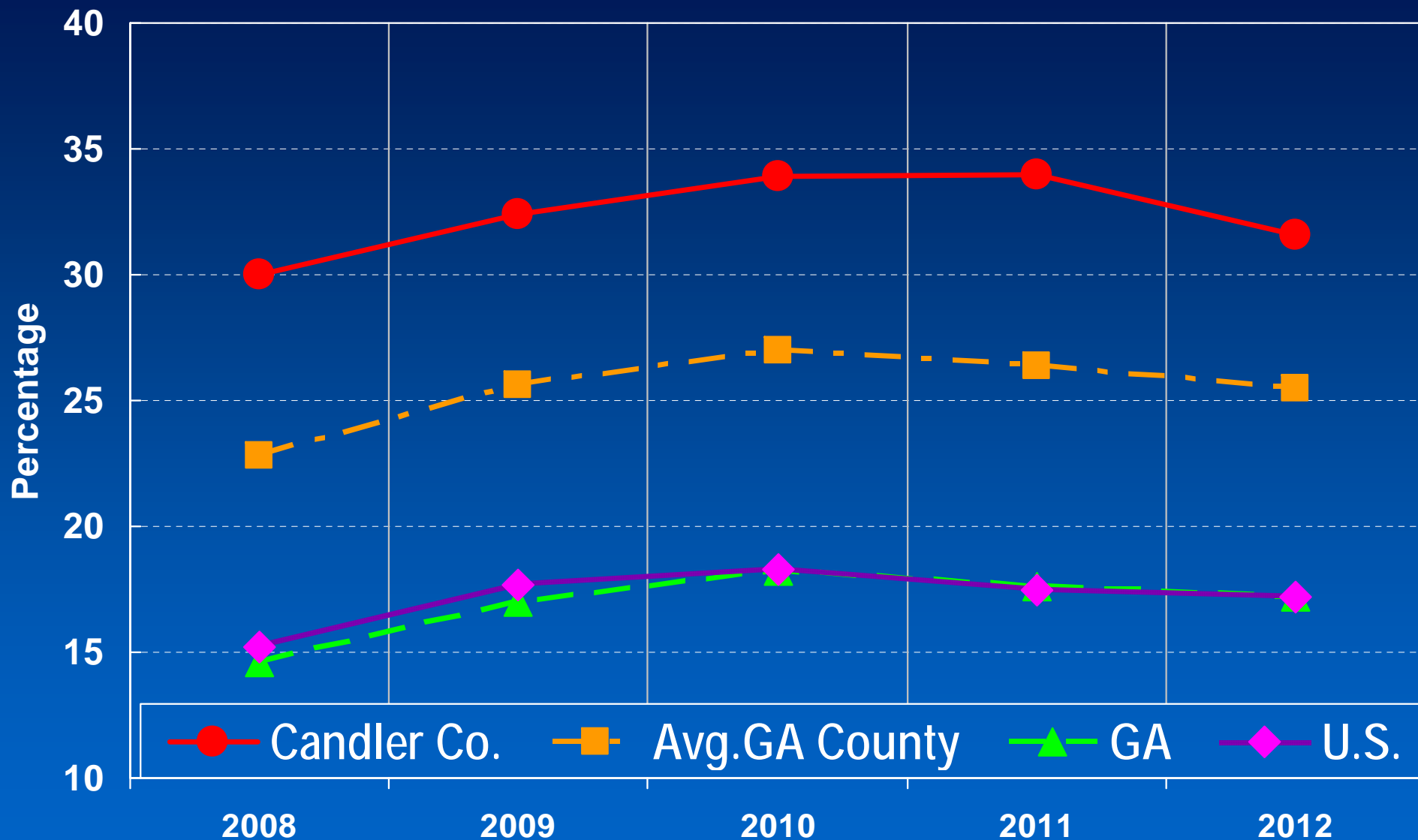

Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2008-2012

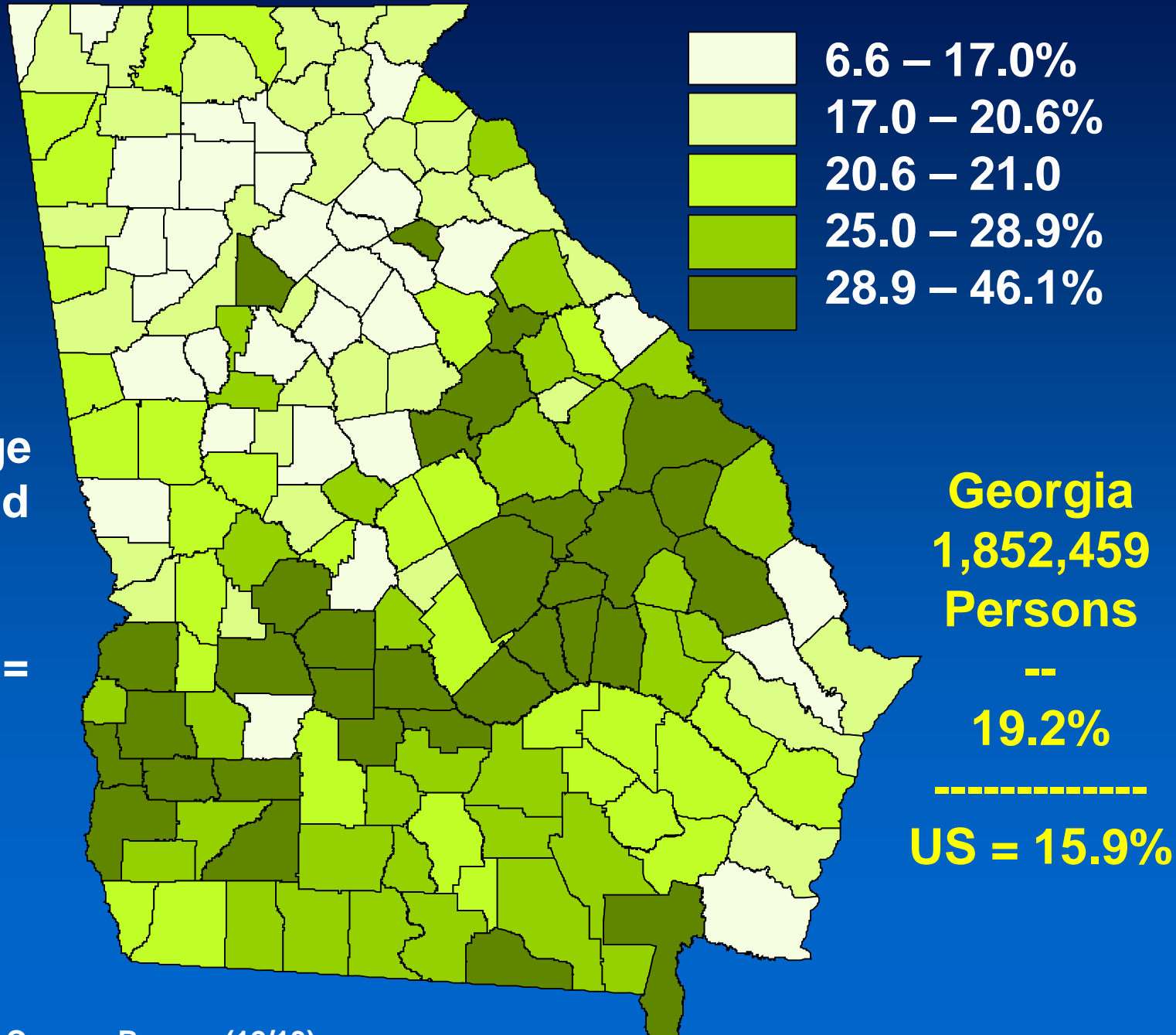

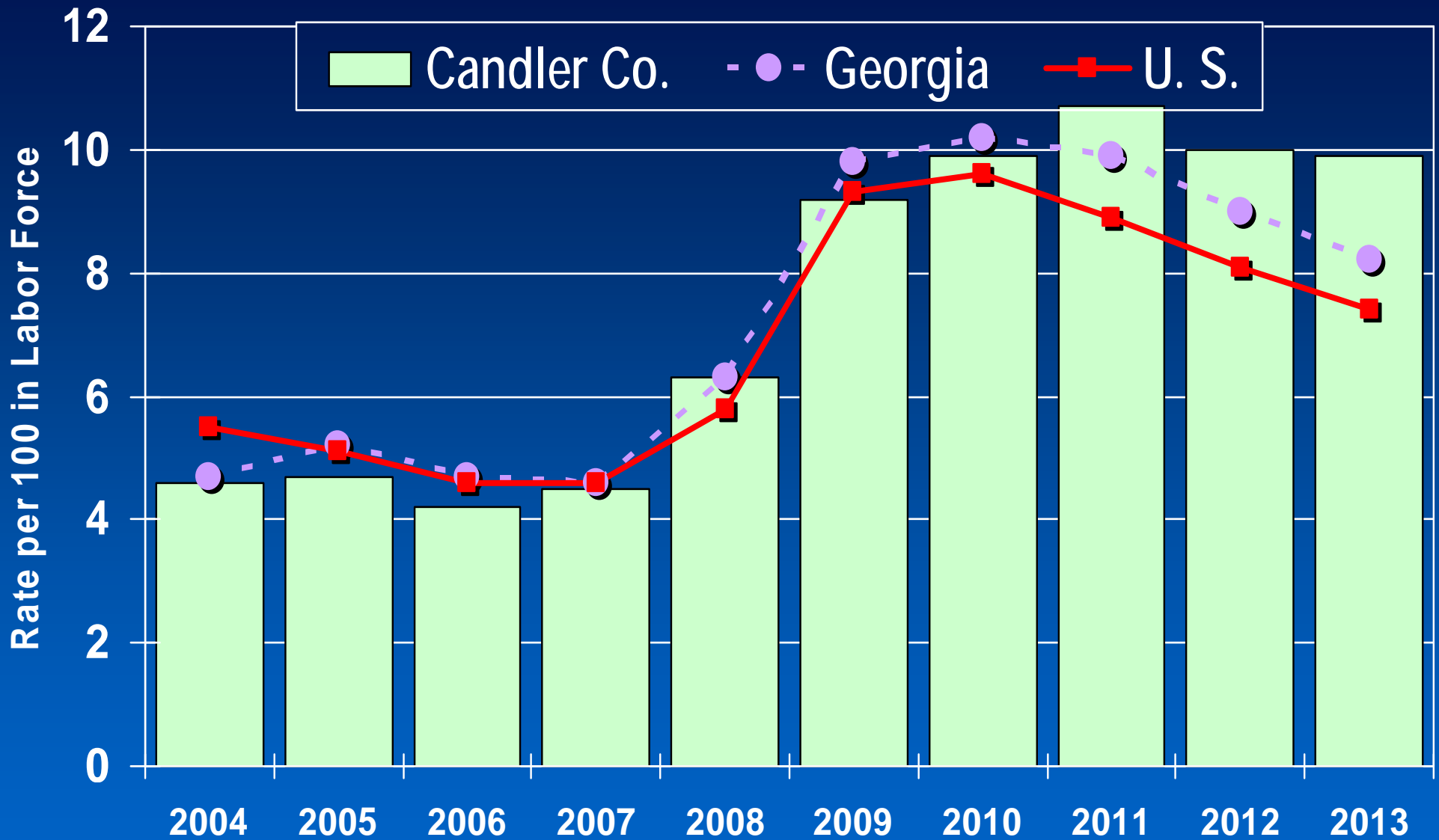

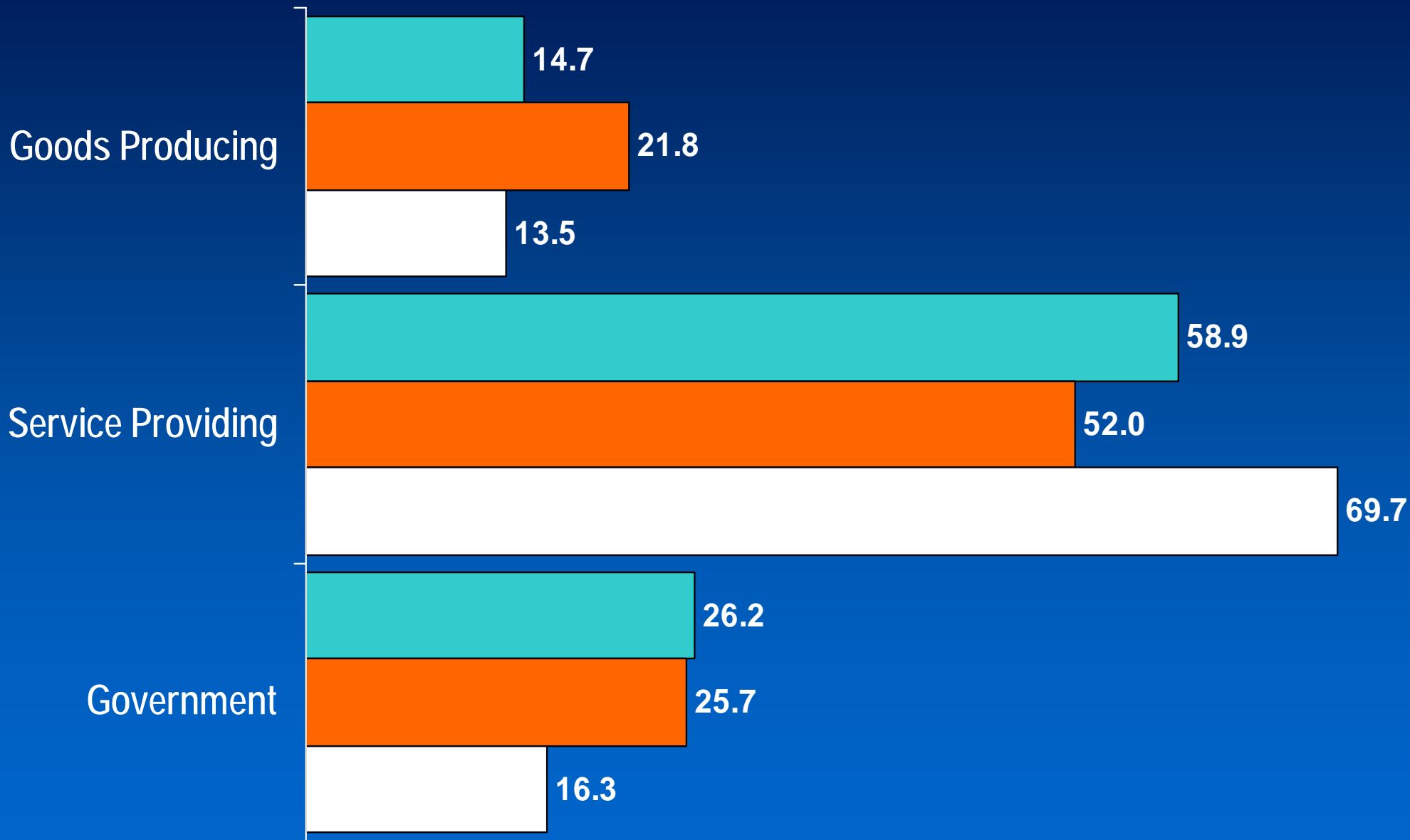

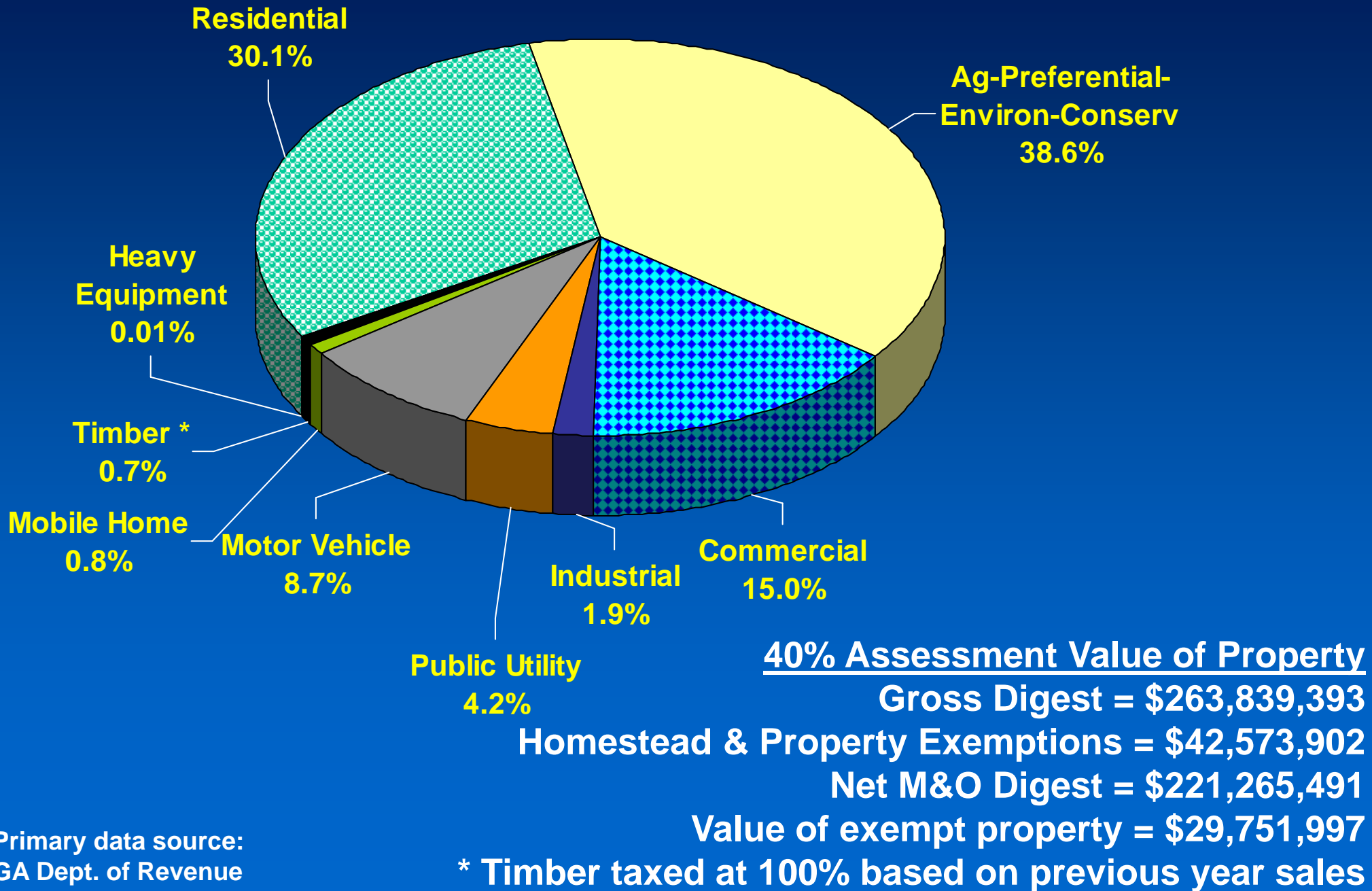

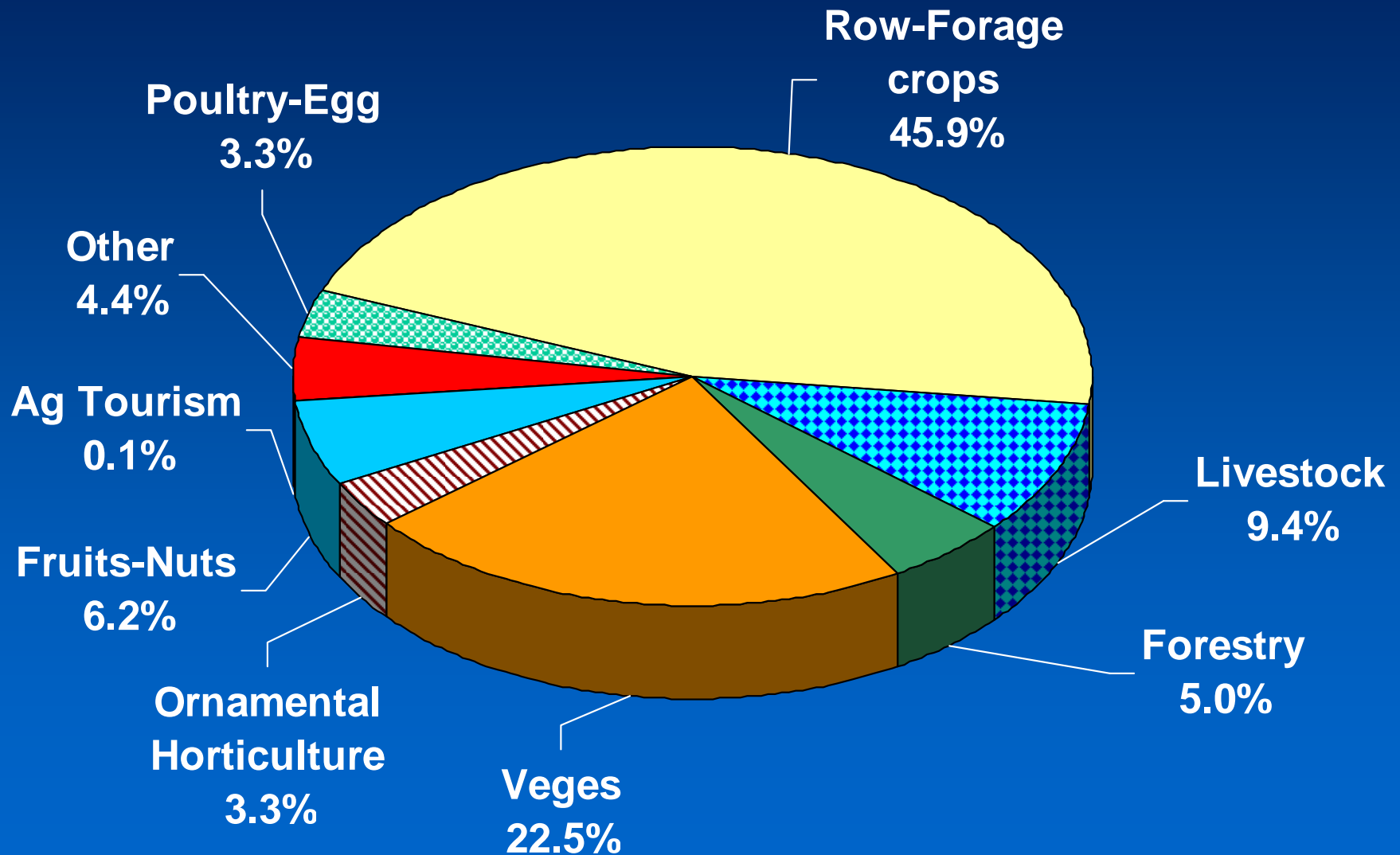

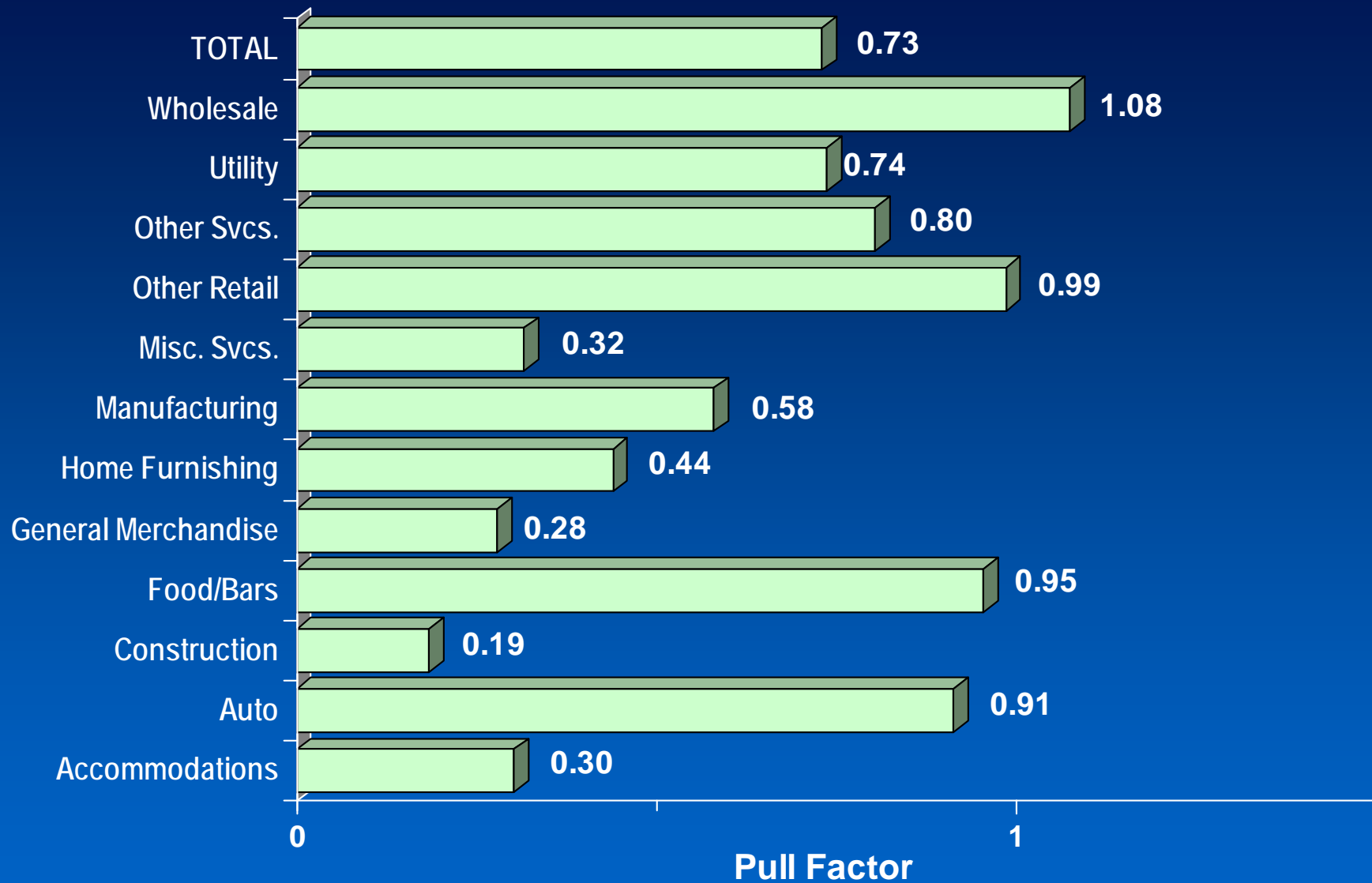
2012 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group

1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2012

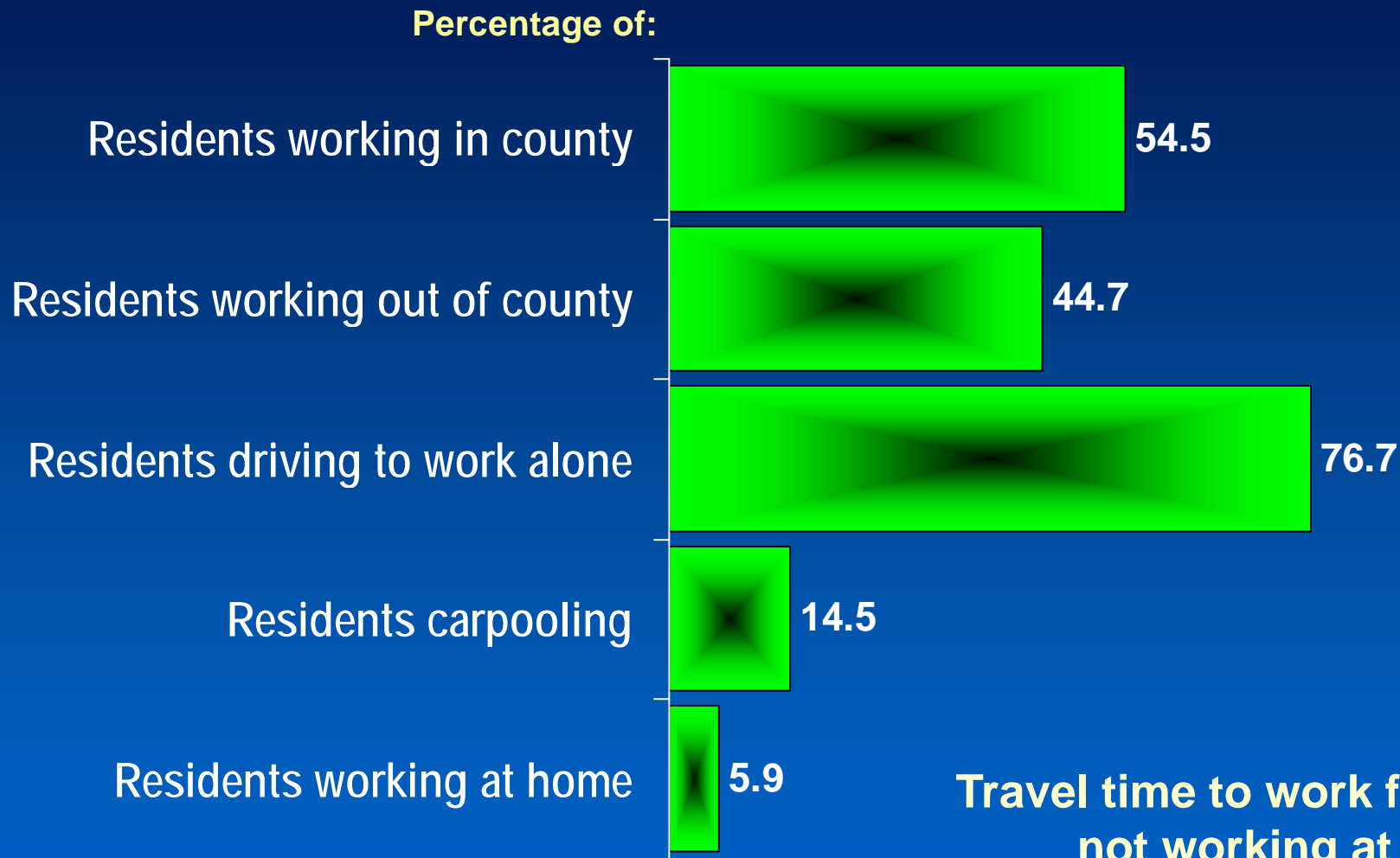

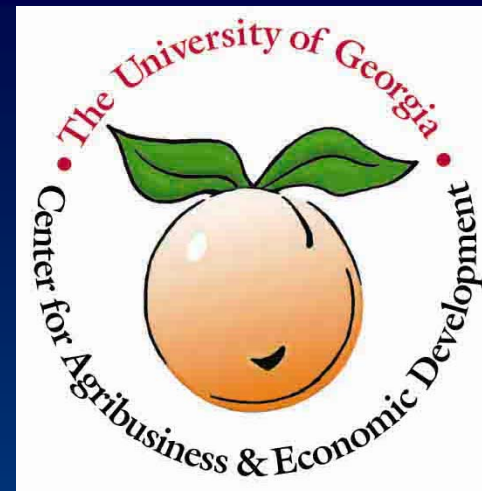
