



2012 Median Age Putnam Co. = 44.1 yrs. GA = 35.7 yrs.





Population Change: 2000-2010






Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2008-2012 American Community Survey 5-Yr. Average





Per Capita Income: 2007-2011 Percentage Change




Per Capita Income: 2007-2011









Components of 2012 Property Tax Gross Digest Putnam County







Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2012 Putnam Co. Total Value = \$73,940,915




1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2012 Putnam Co. = \$3,755,413

Commuting to Work: 2008-2012 American Community Survey 5-Yr. Average Putnam Co. Resident Workers = 8,839




Mean travel time to work = 28.4 minutes
