

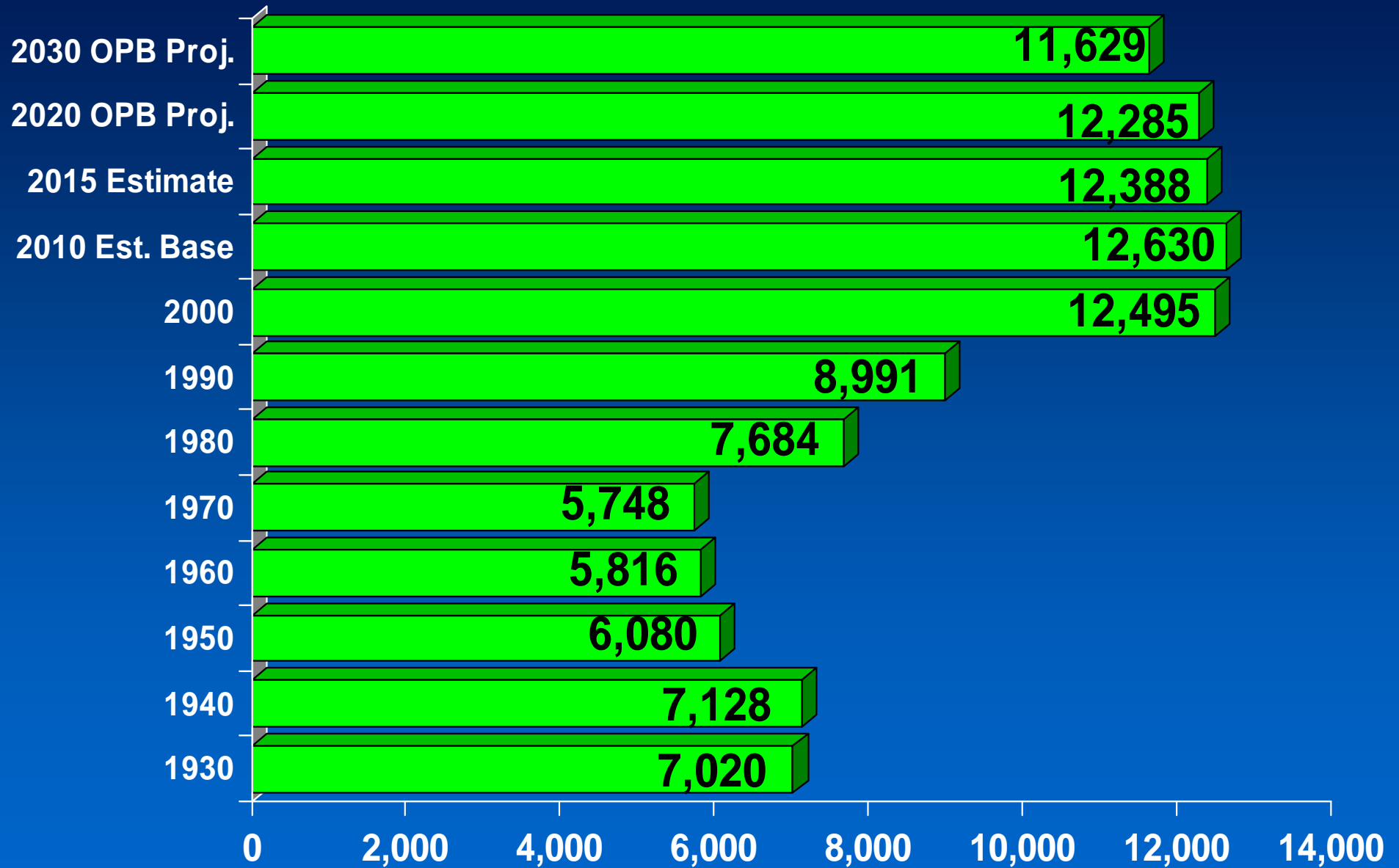

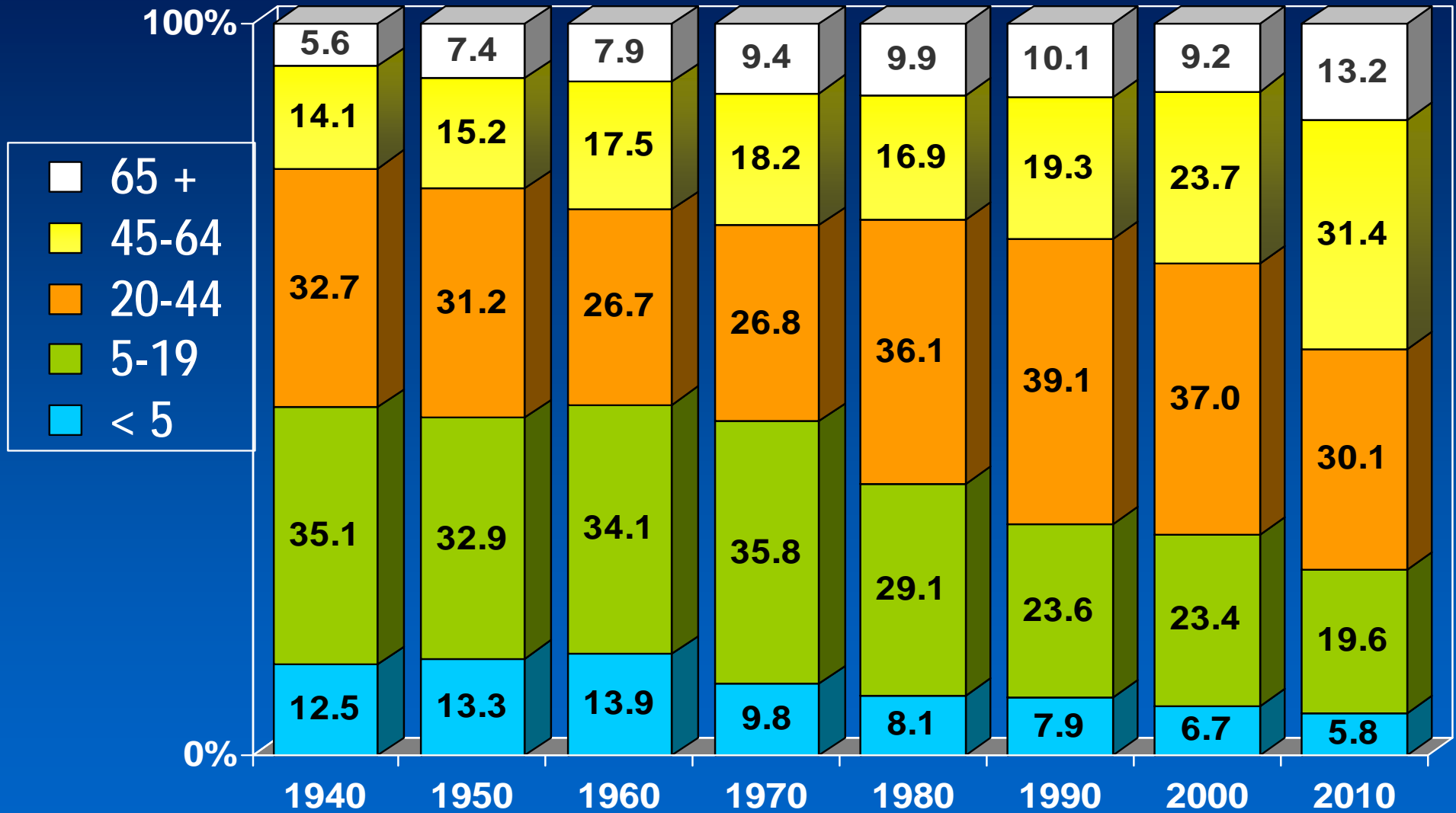

Population Composition by Age Crawford County

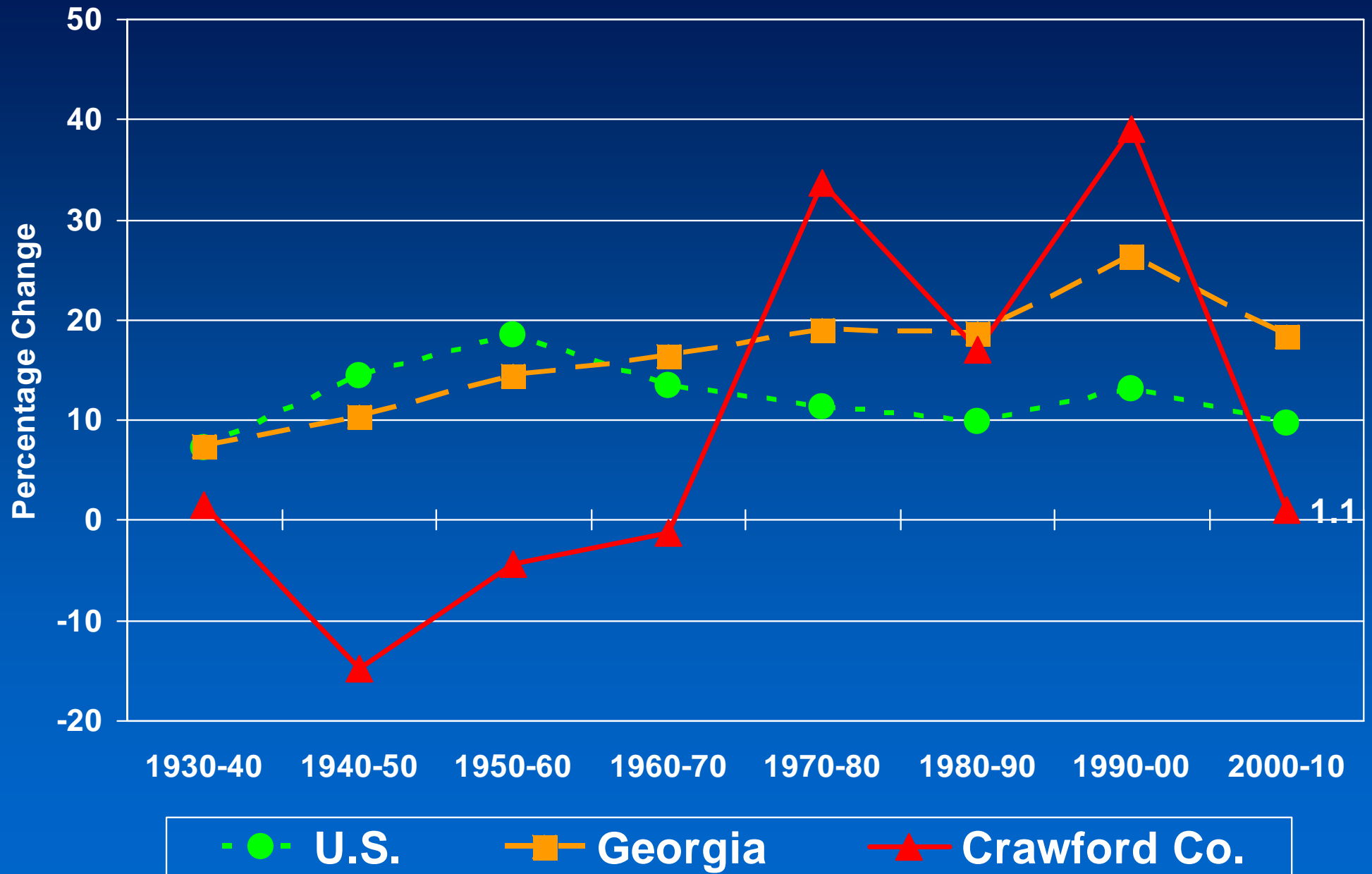

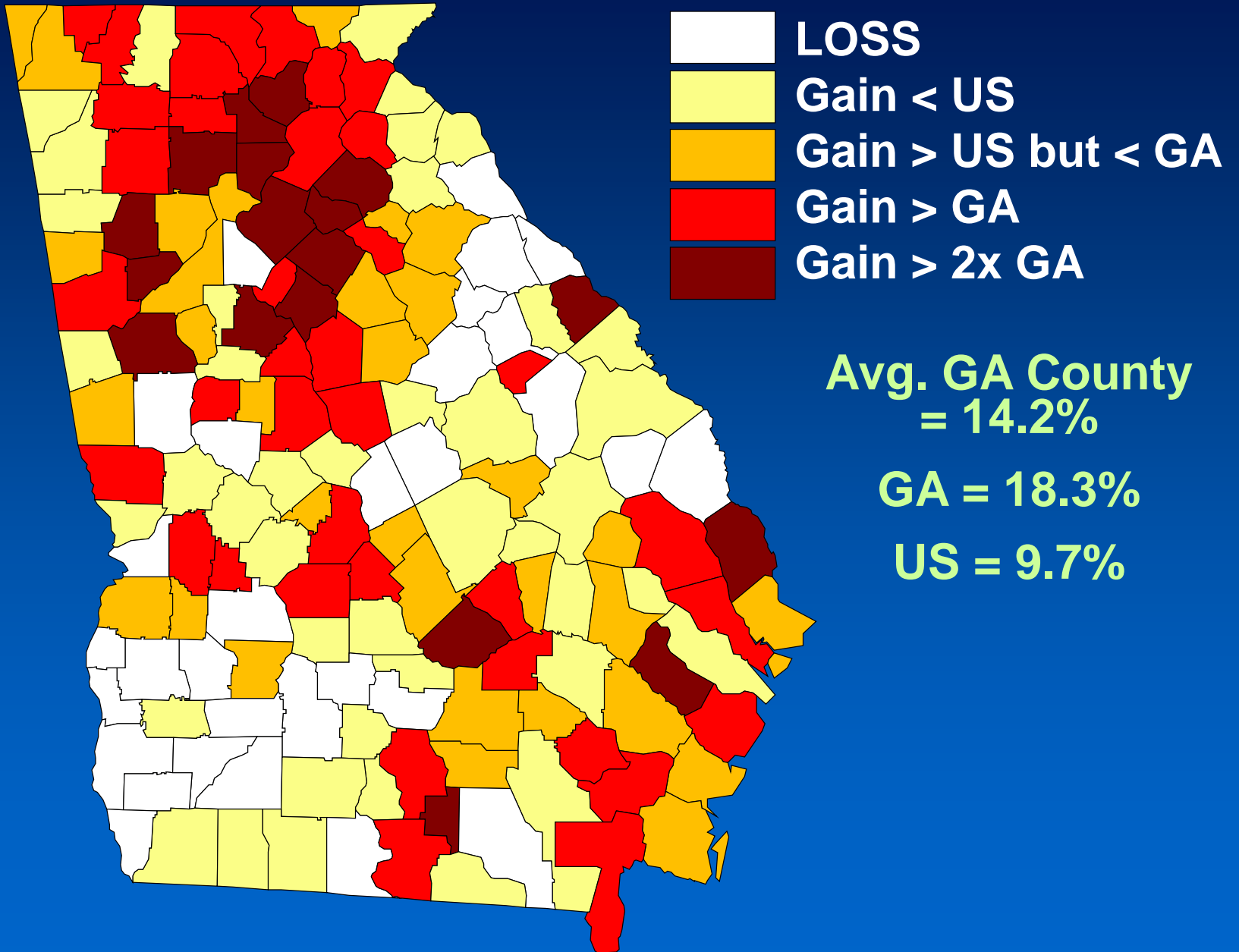

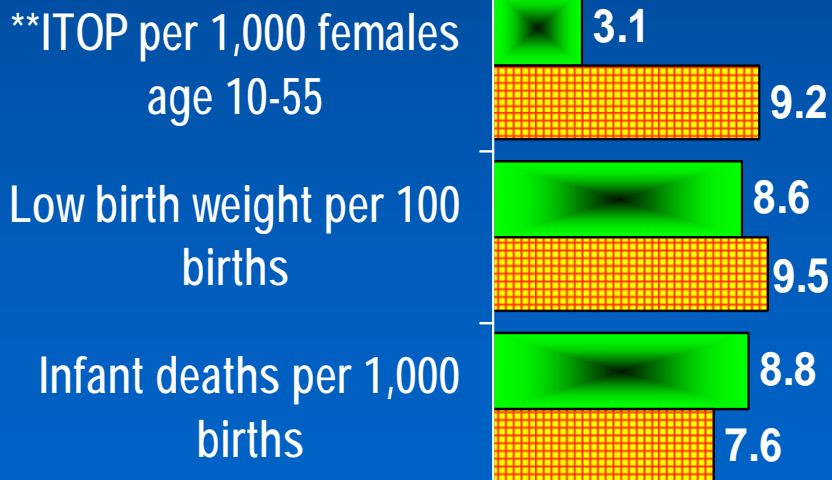

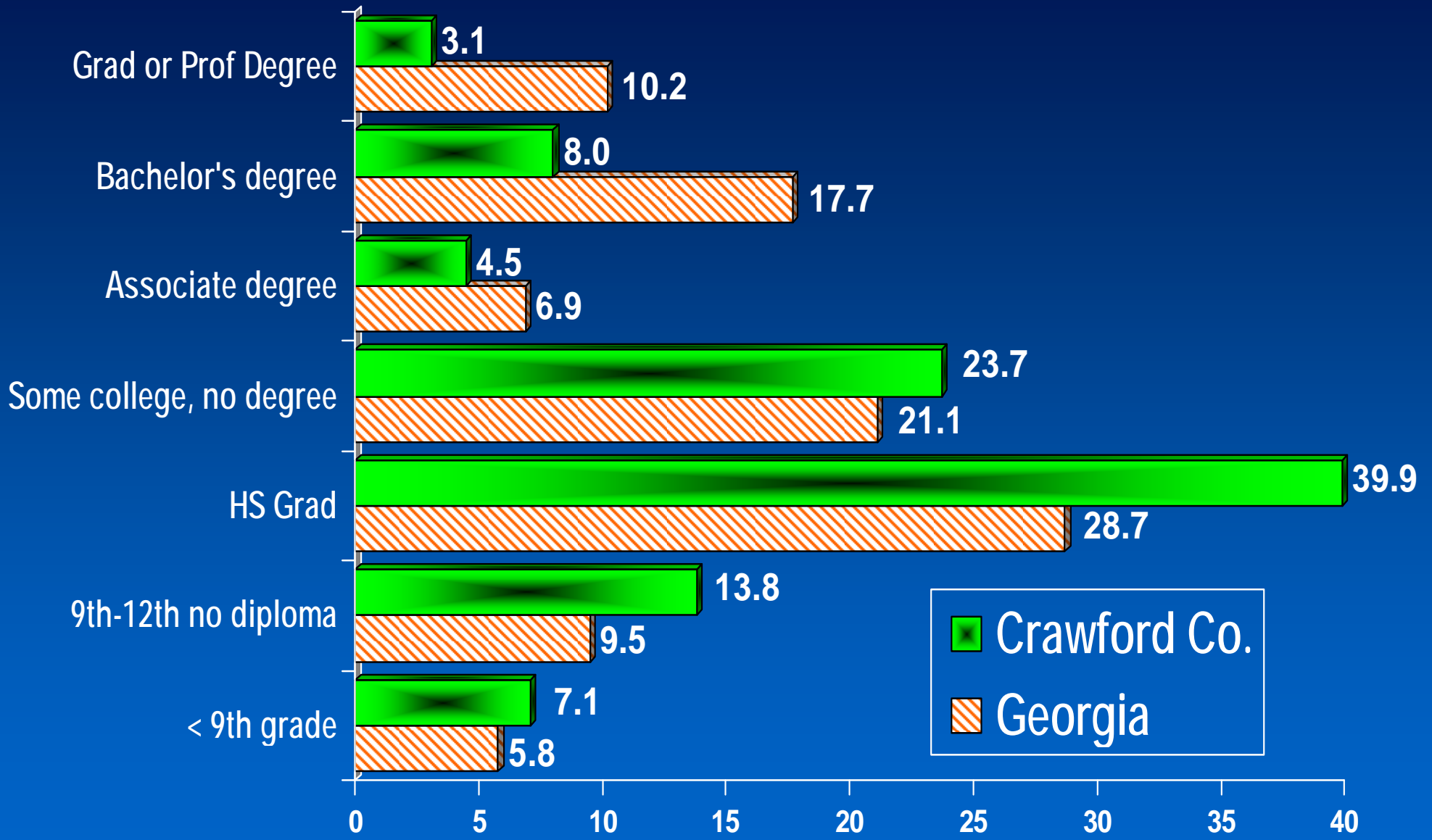

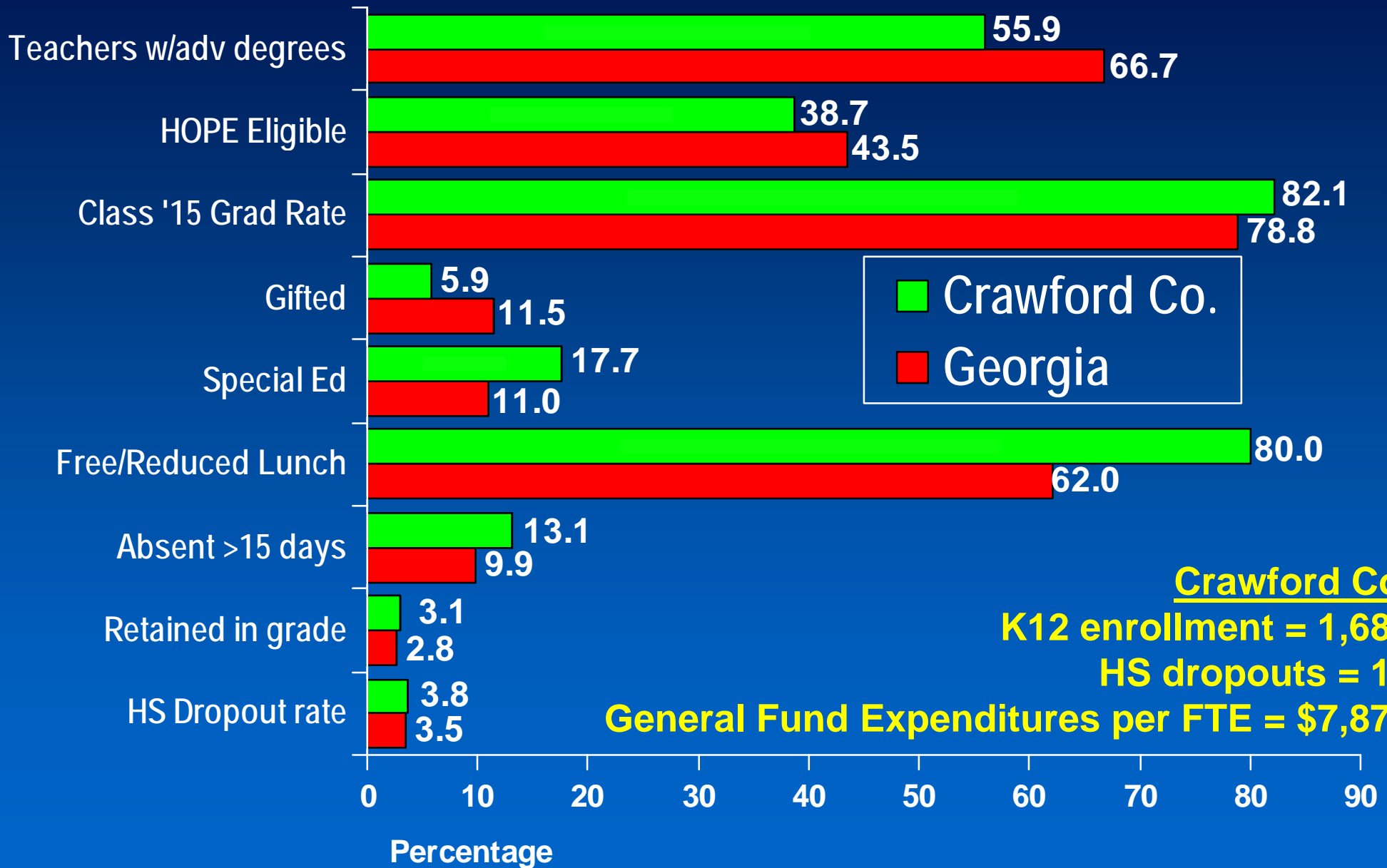

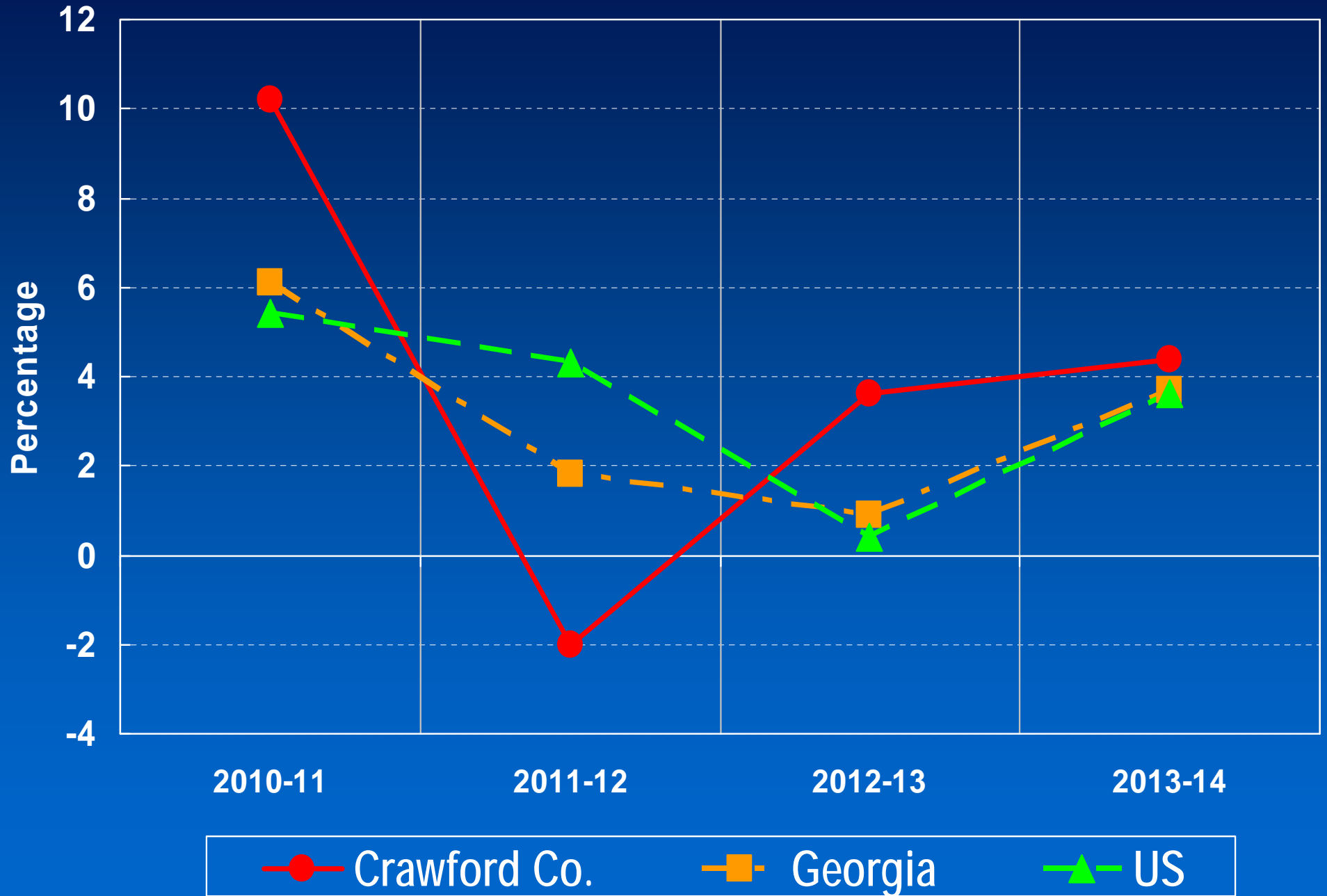

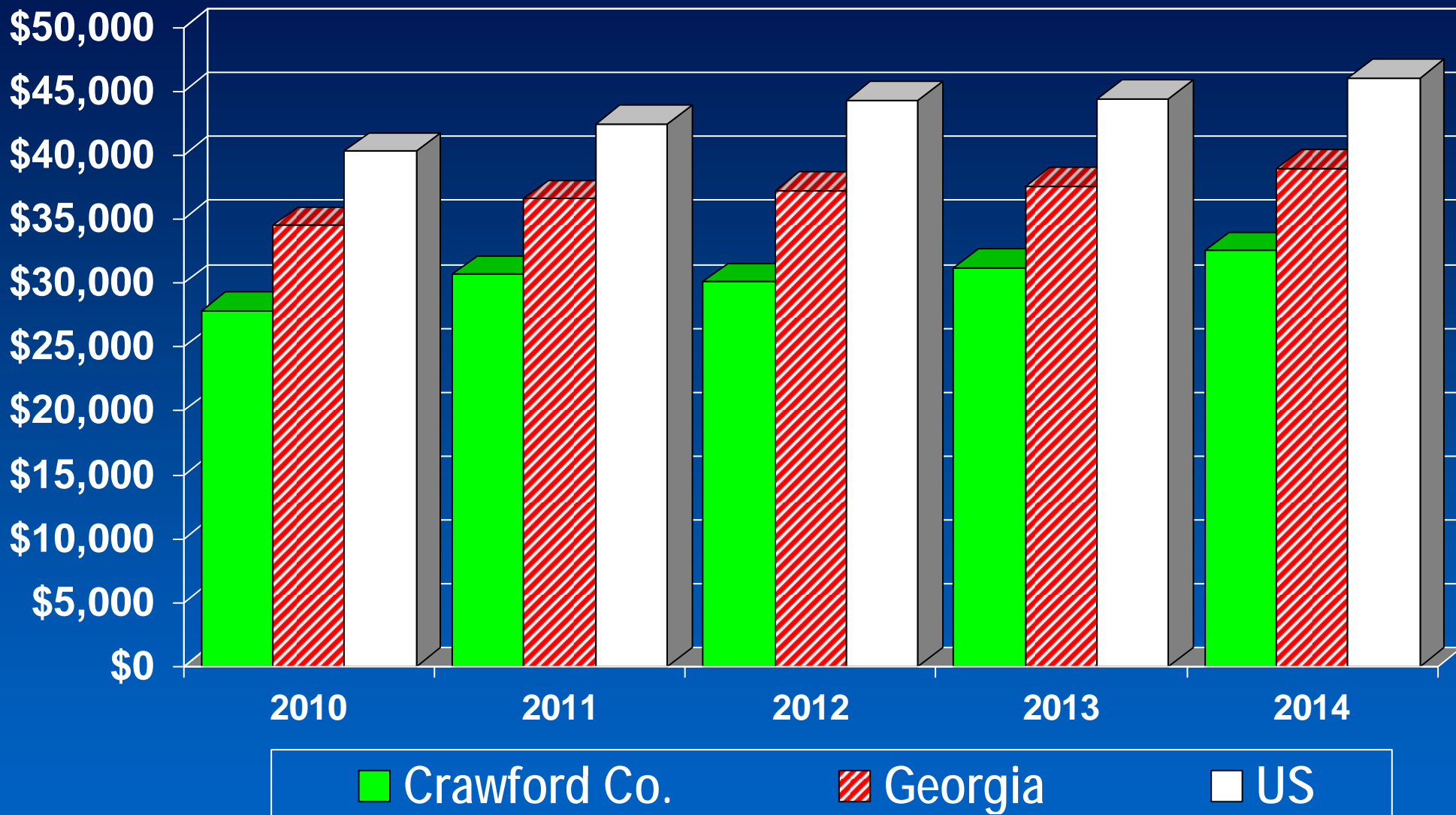

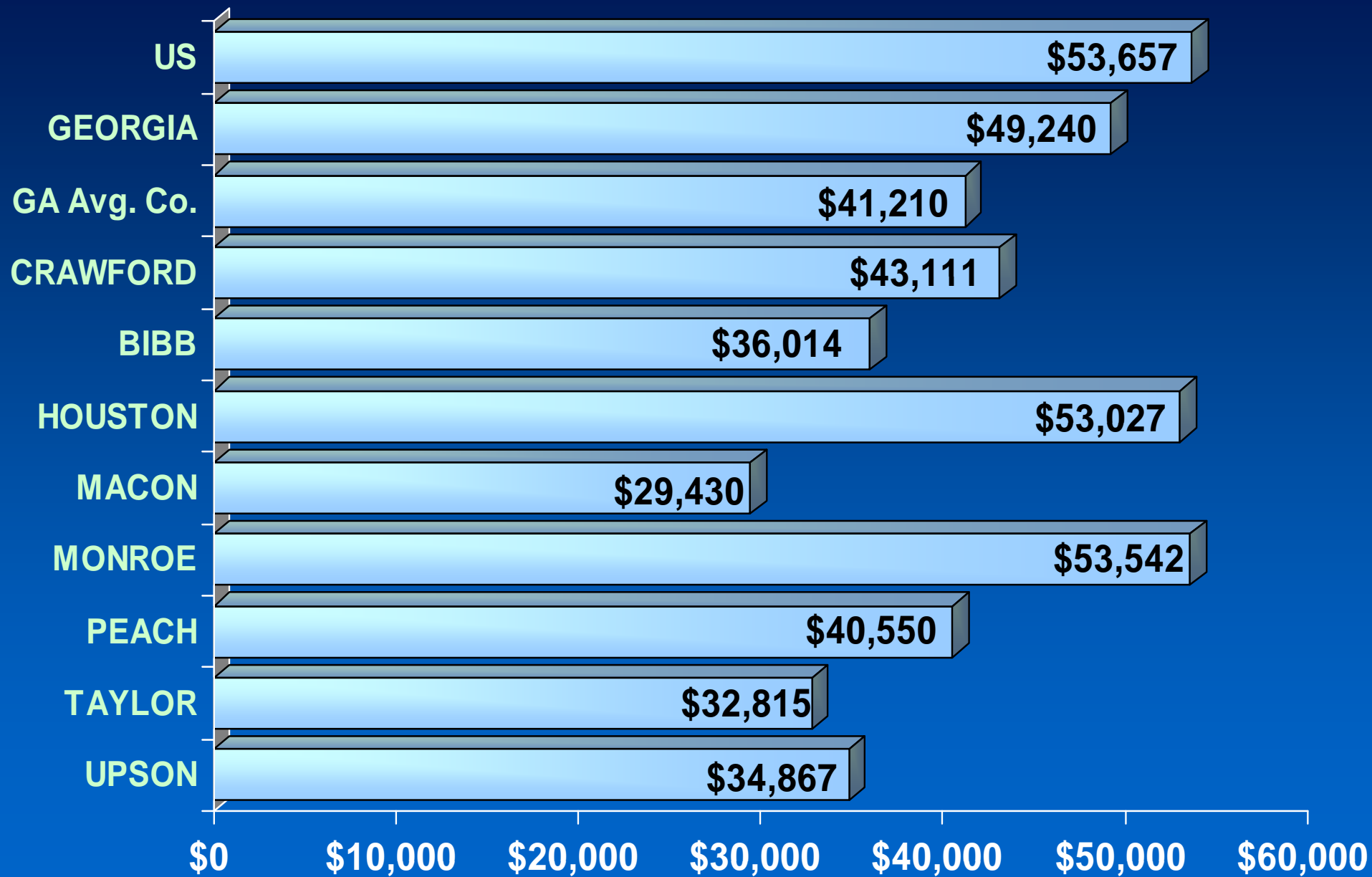

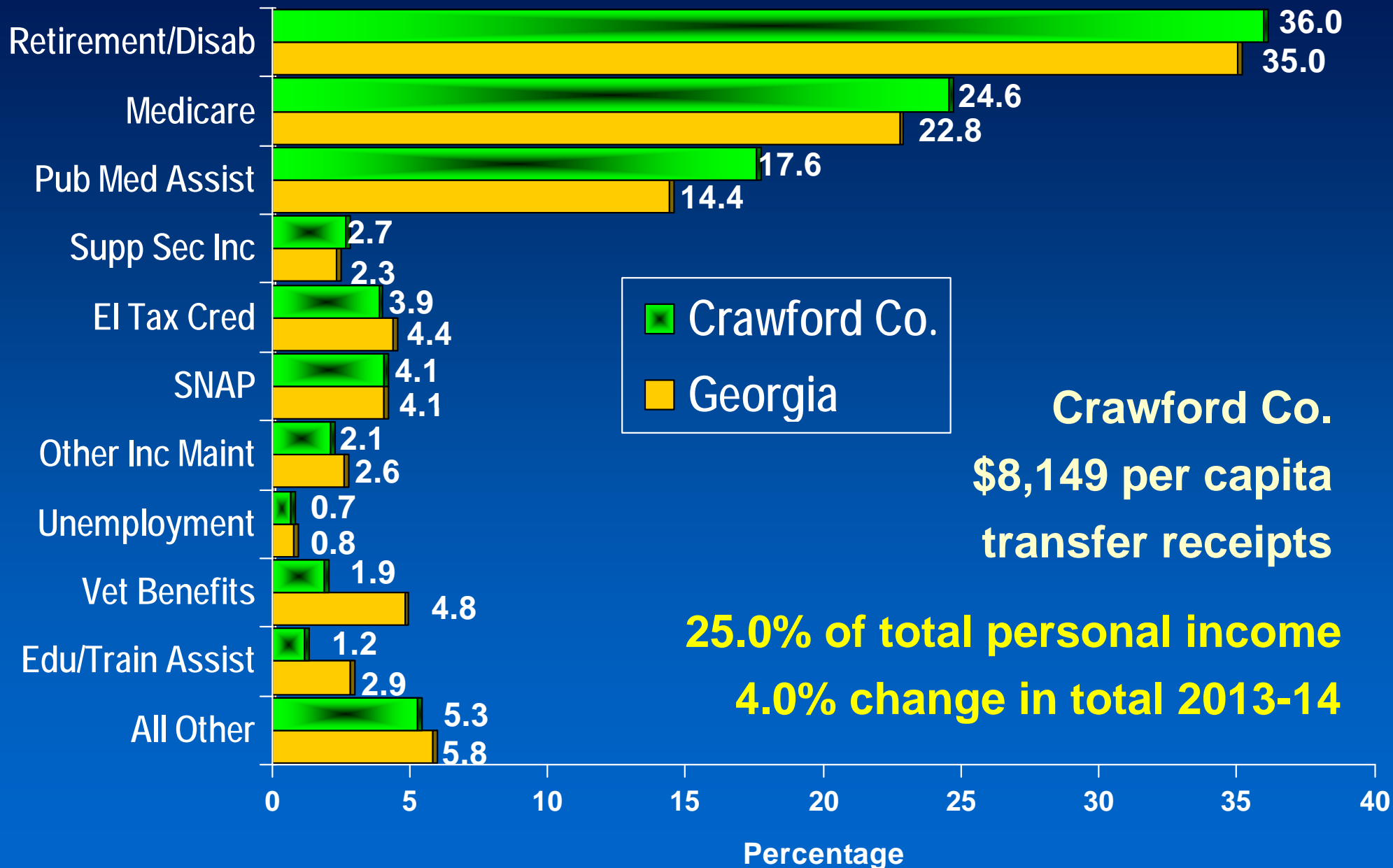

Median Household Income 2014 Model-Based Estimates

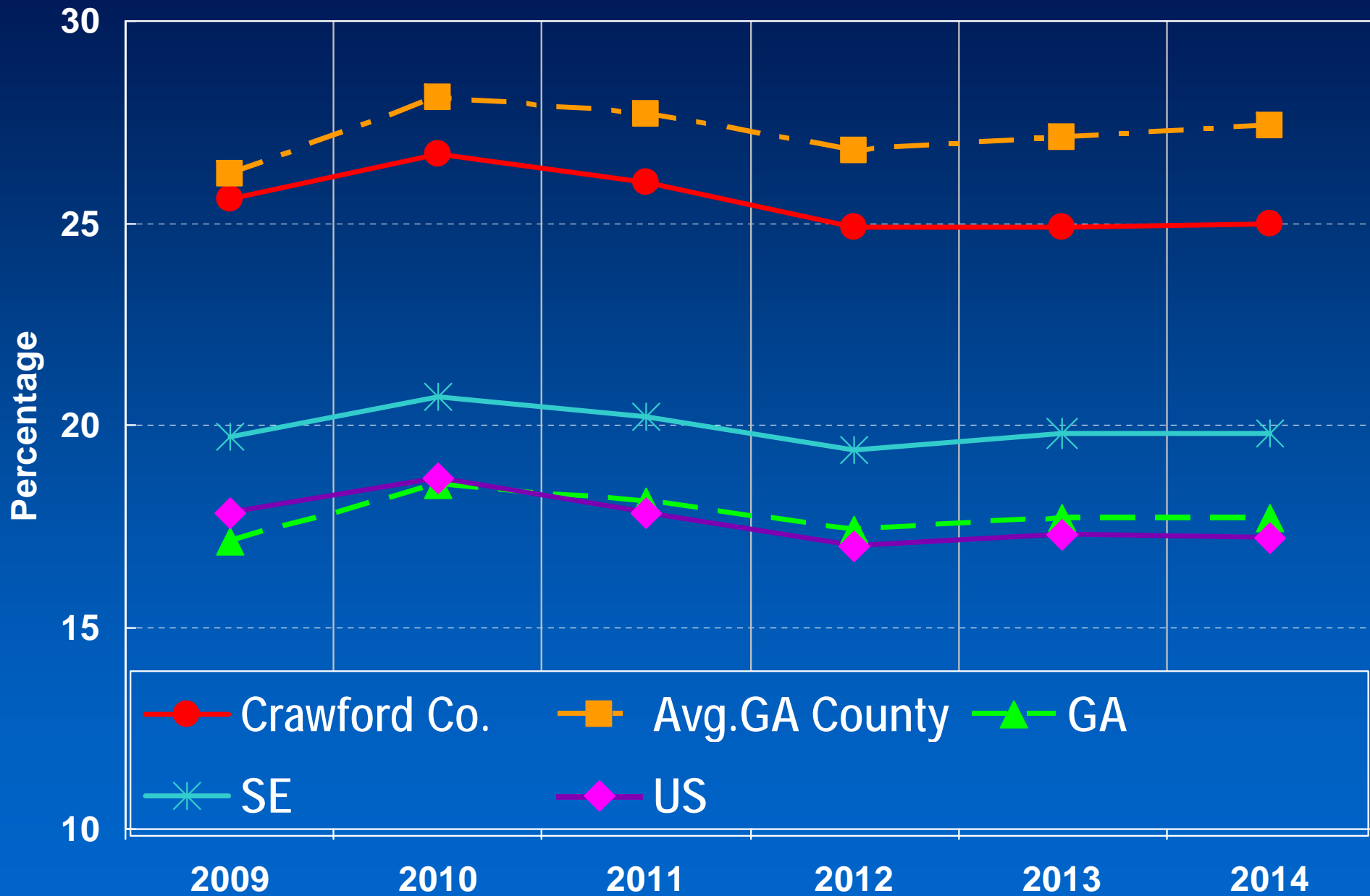


Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2014

Crawford Co. Total = \$100,937,000



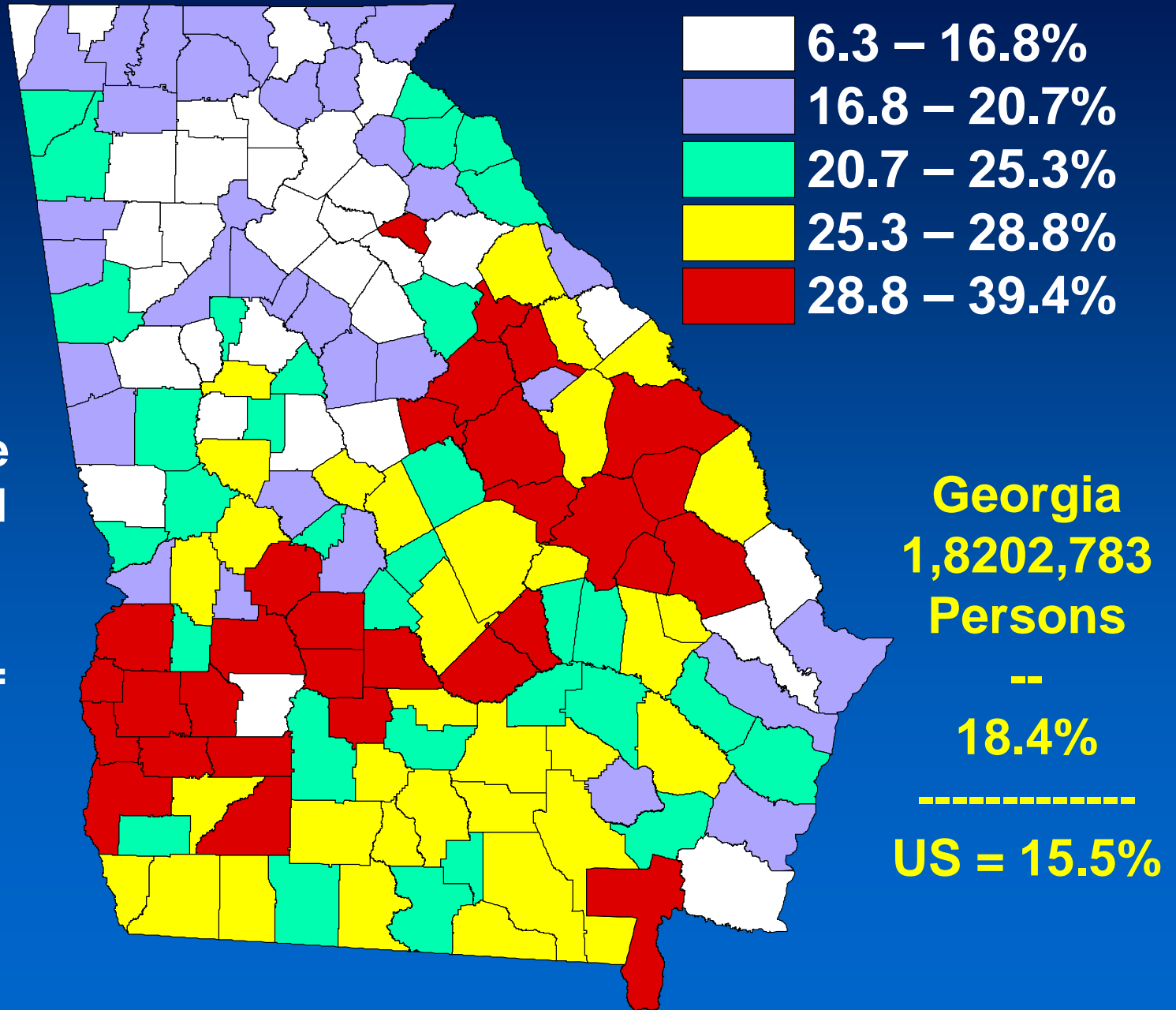
Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2009-2014

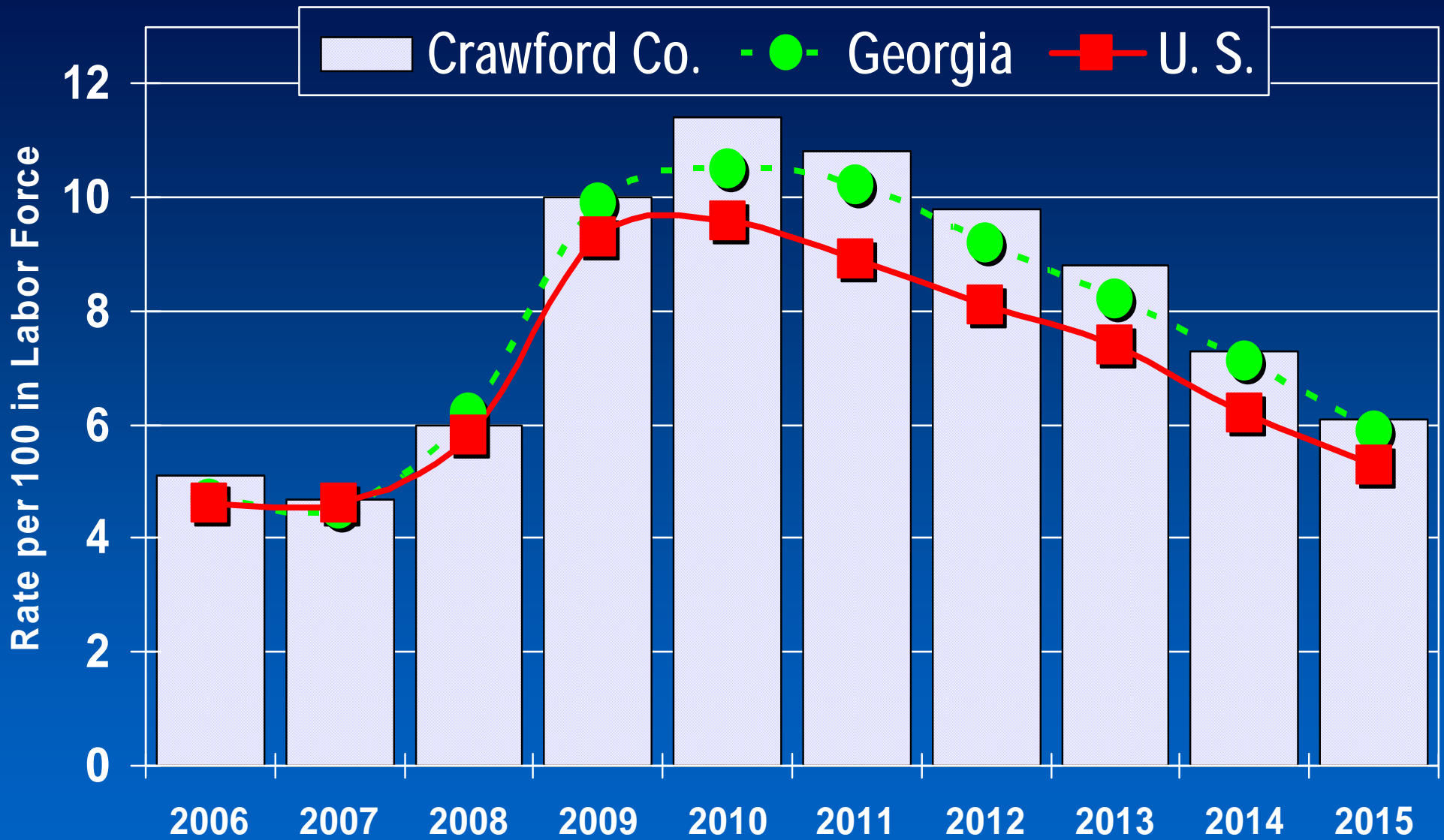

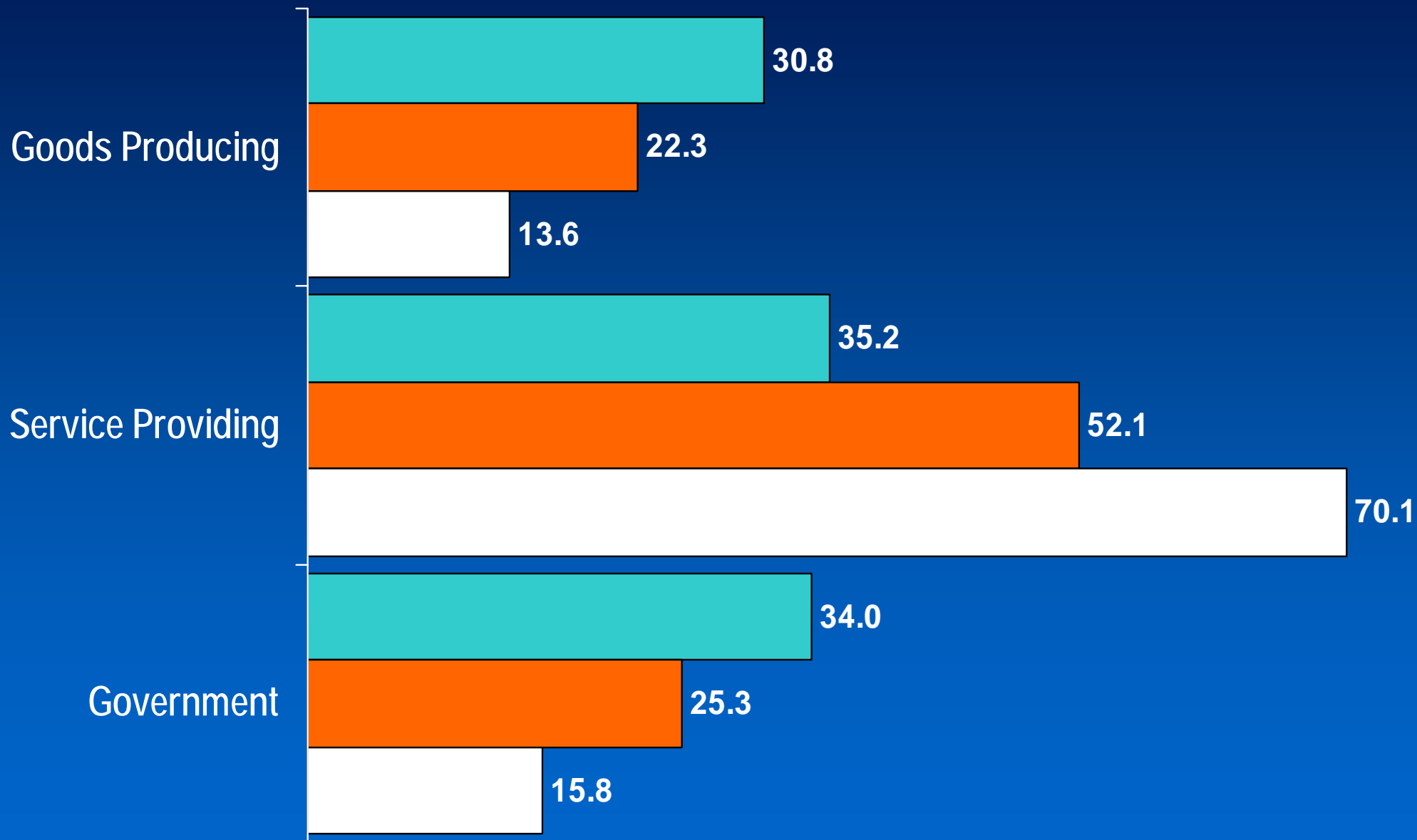

Employment Comparisons by Industry Group: 2014

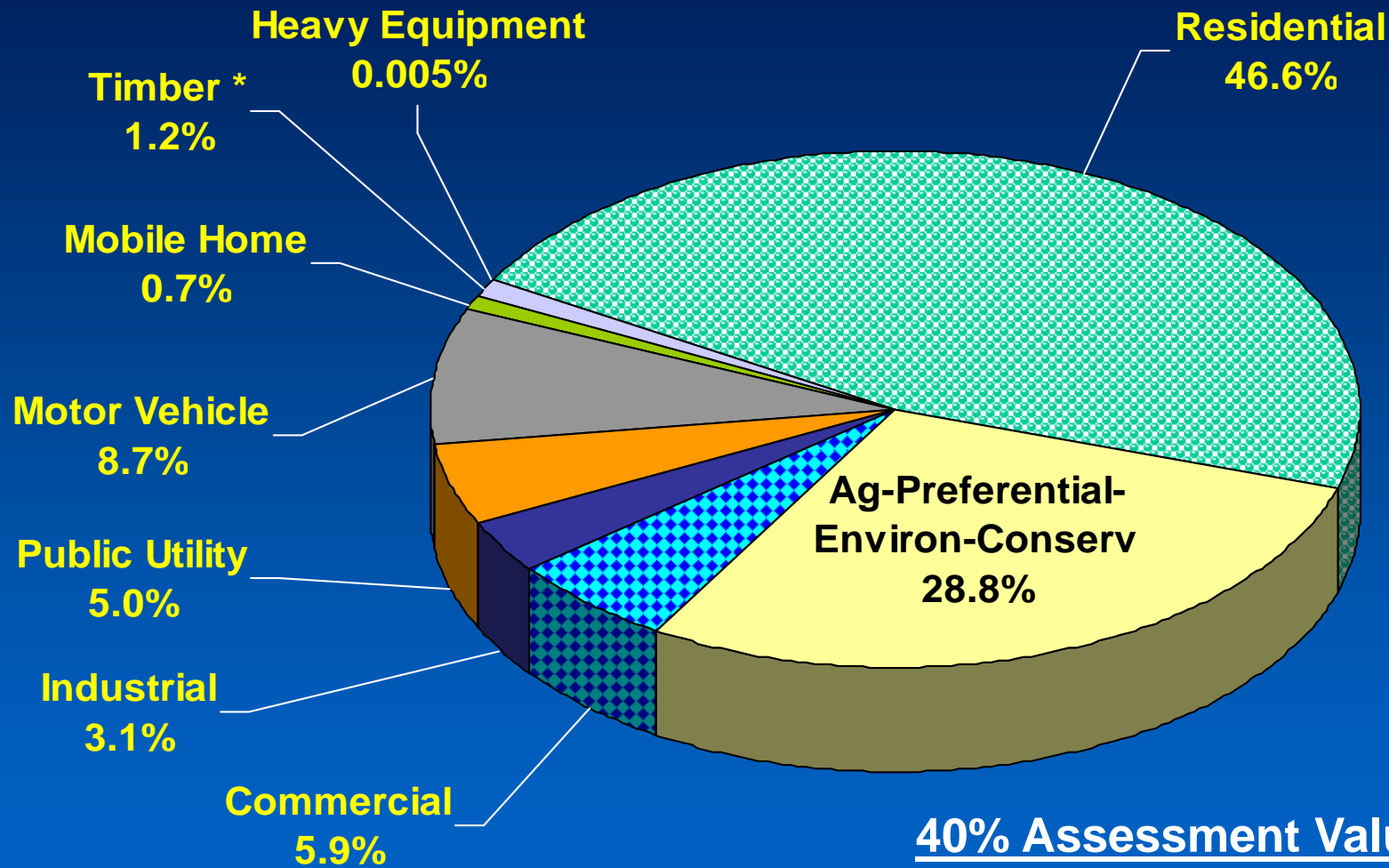

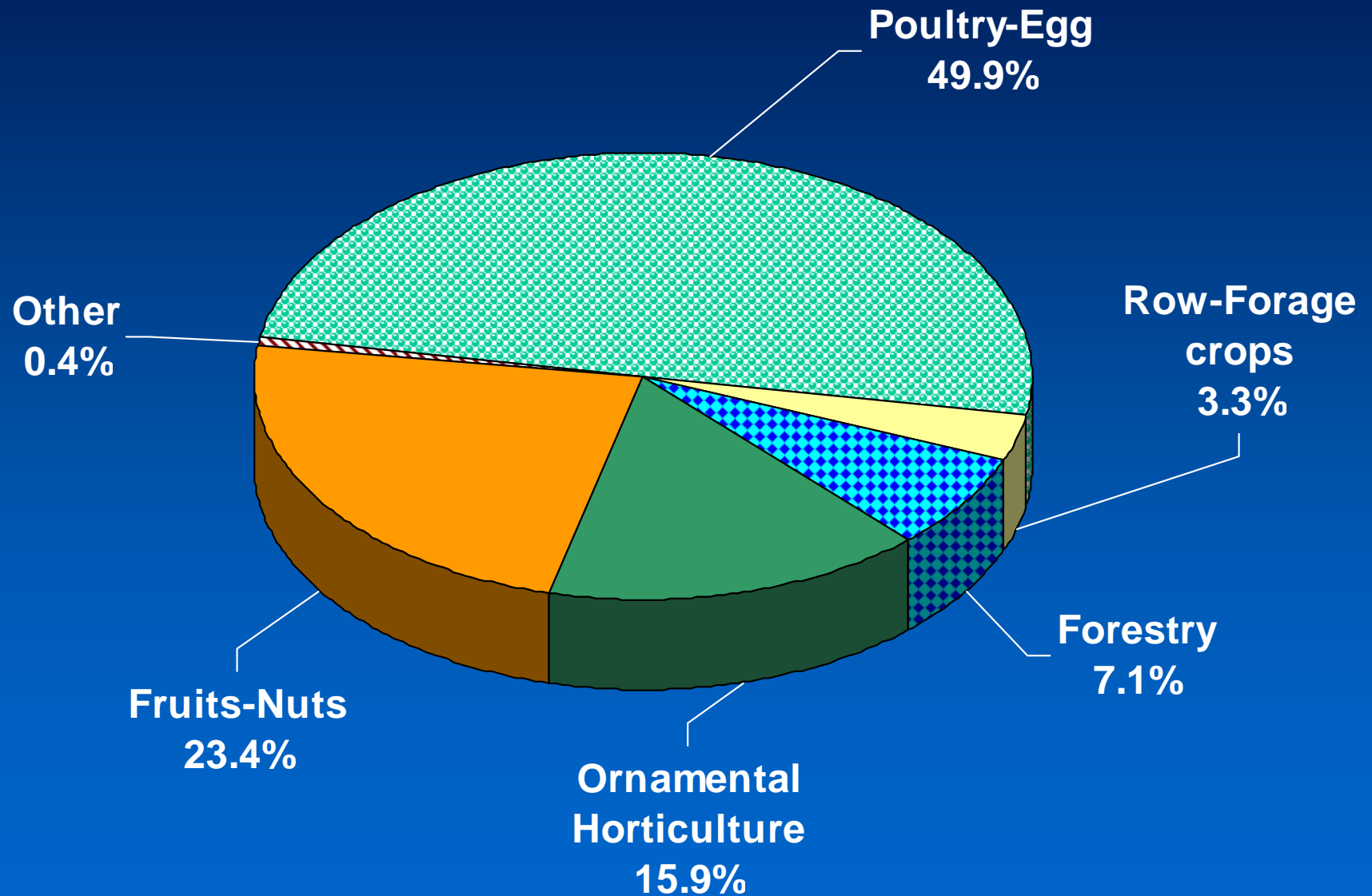

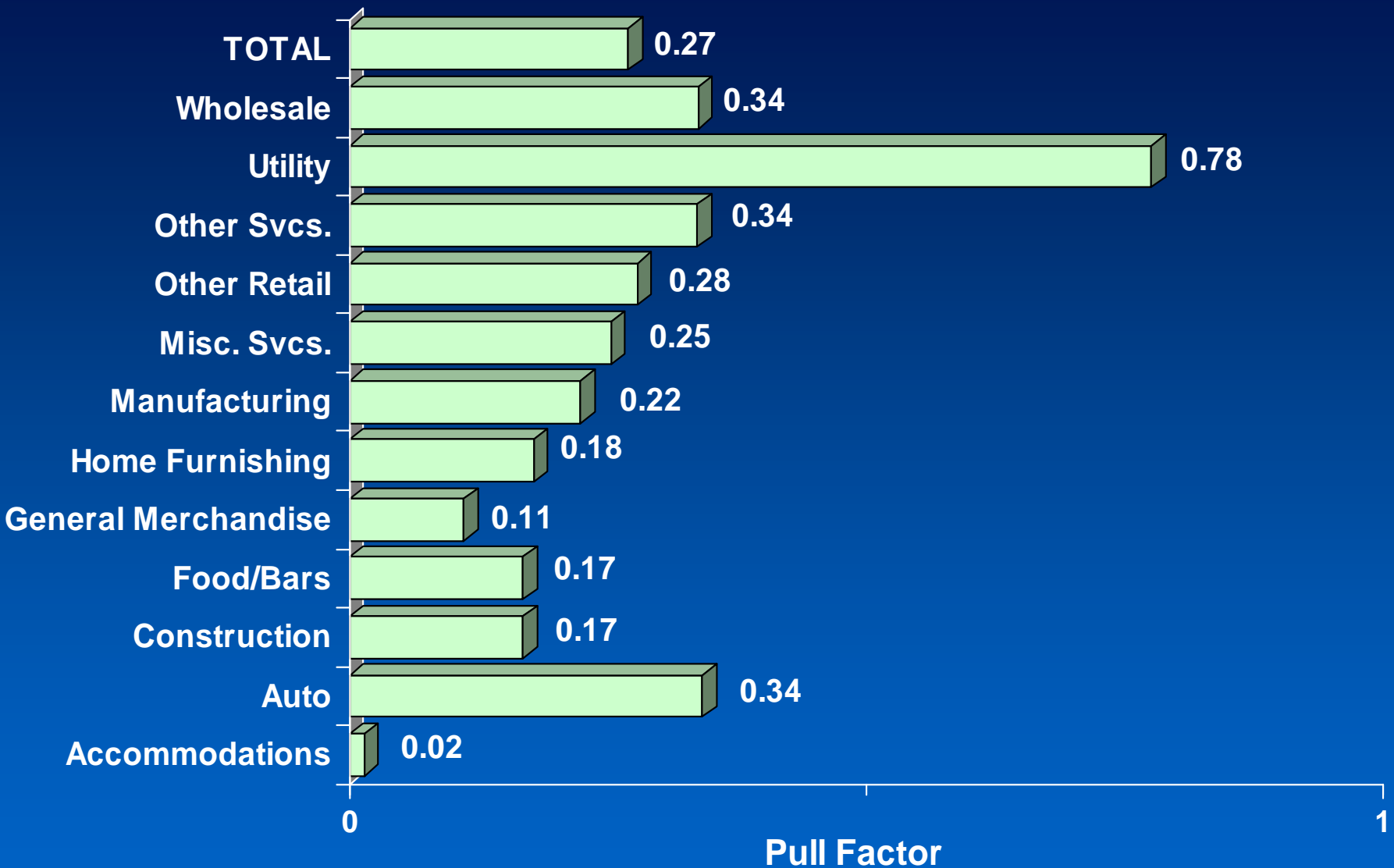

1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2014

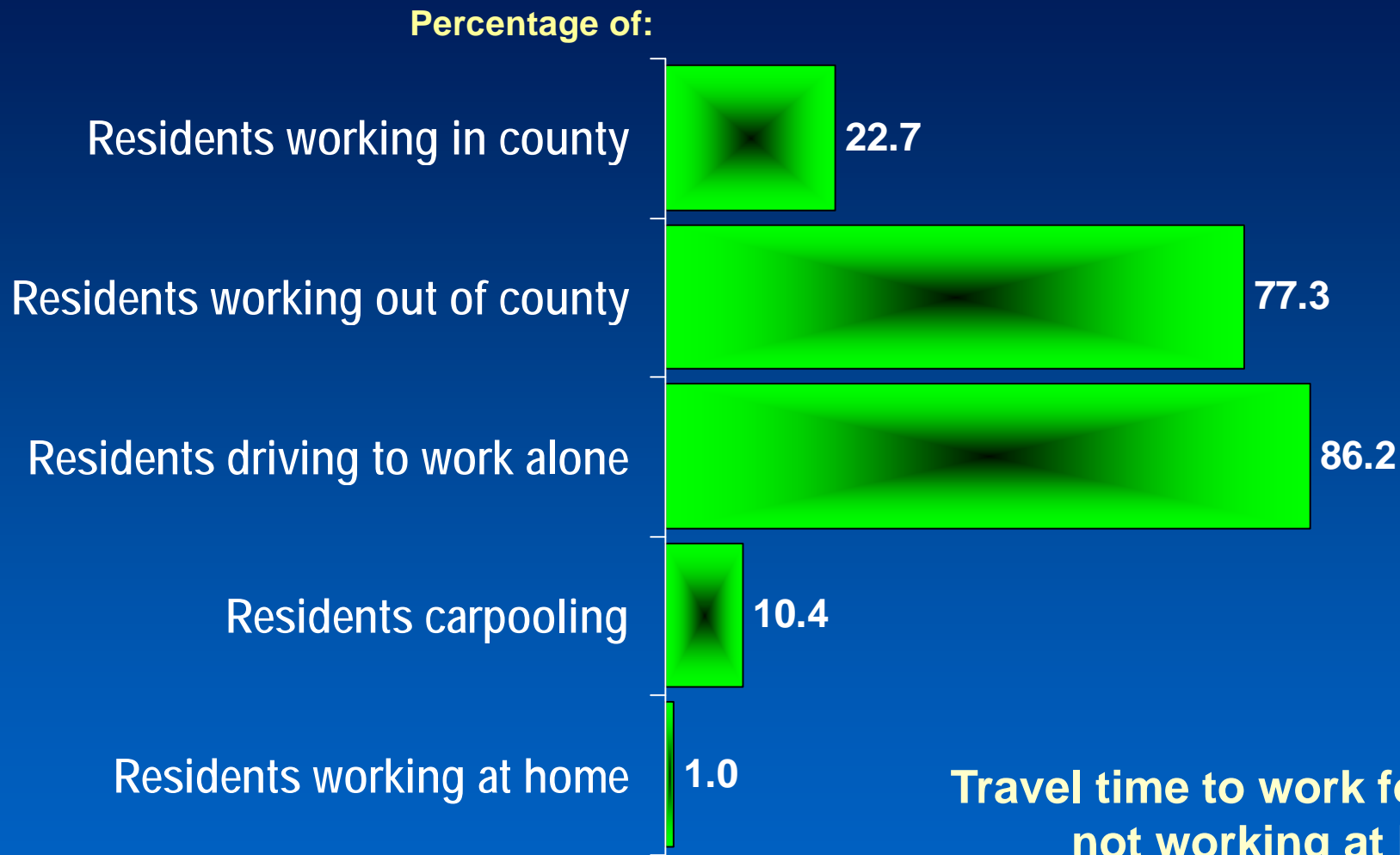

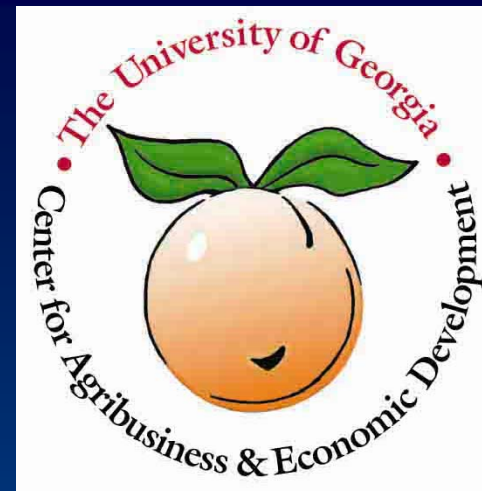
