



#### Population Composition by Age McDuffie County









#### Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2010-2014 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey









#### Median Household Income 2014 Model-Based Estimates





# Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2009-2014









#### Components of 2014 Property Tax Gross Digest McDuffie County





#### 1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2014 McDuffie Co. Total = \$3,329,777




A "pull factor" of 1.0 means that the county's sales are what would be expected based upon the number of residents and their relative wealth.

#### Commuting to Work: 2010-2014 5 Yr. Average – American Community Survey


