









## 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey











## Median Household Income 2014 Model-Based Estimates




# Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2014

## Wayne Co. Total = \$271,462,000




# Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2009-2014



# Civilian Labor Force Average Annual Unemployment Rates









# 2014 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group



# 1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2014




