







Population Change: 2000-2010








Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2010-2014 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey





Per Capita Income: 2010-2014



Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2009-2014



Civilian Labor Force Average Annual Unemployment Rates











2014 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group Whitfield Co. Total Value = \$69,557,580




1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2014 Whitfield Co. Total = \$17,199,360


Travel time to work for residents not working at home:
