



Population Composition by Age Banks County











Per Capita Income: 2011-2015 Percentage Change




Per Capita Income: 2011-2015



Median Household Income 2015 Model-Based Estimates




Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2015 Banks Co. Total = \$140,932,000

Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2015











2015 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group Banks Co. Total Value = \$273,157,478




1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2015 Banks Co. Total = \$3,030,428
