



Population Composition by Age Clayton County







Population Change: 2010-2015









Per Capita Income: 2011-2015 Percentage Change





Per Capita Income: 2011-2015



Median Household Income 2015 Model-Based Estimates




Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2015 Clayton Co. Total = \$1,848,150,000

Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2015















2015 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group Clayton Co. Total Value = \$47,922,878




