



Population Composition by Age Morgan County







Population Change: 2010-2016













Median Household Income 2015 Model-Based Estimates





Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2015













2015 Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group Morgan Co. Total Value = \$150,560,729




1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2015 Morgan Co. Total = \$3,461,935
