



Population Composition by Age Polk County





Population Change: 2010-2016






Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2011-2015 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey





Per Capita Income: 2011-2015



Median Household Income 2015 Model-Based Estimates




Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2015 Polk Co. Total = \$387,314,000


Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2015











1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2015 Polk Co. Total = \$4,463,781


