



#### Population Composition by Age Thomas County





## Population Change: 2010-2016







#### Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2011-2015 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey




Percent of Persons Age 25+



## Per Capita Income: 2011-2015 Percentage Change





## Per Capita Income: 2011-2015





#### Median Household Income 2015 Model-Based Estimates





# Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2015











#### 1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2016 Thomas Co. Total = \$7,636,741


