

Population Composition by Age Carroll County







Population Change: 2010-2016







Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2012-2016 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey











Median Household Income 2016 Model-Based Estimates





Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2016





Civilian Labor Force Average Annual Unemployment Rates











1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2016 Carroll Co. Total = \$15,884,997


