



Population Composition by Age McIntosh County







Population Change: 2010-2016








Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2012-2016 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey

Per Capita Income: 2012-2016





Median Household Income 2016 Model-Based Estimates




Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2016 McIntosh Co. Total = \$120,056,000

Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2016















1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2016 McIntosh Co. Total = \$1,186,420


