



Population Composition by Age Polk County







Population Change: 2010-2017







Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2012-2016 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey




Percent of Persons Age 25+





Per Capita Income: 2012-2016






Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2016 Polk Co. Total = \$396,396,000

Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2016









Components of 2017 Property Tax Gross Digest Polk County







1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2016 Polk Co. Total = \$4,404,003


