



### Population Composition by Age Washington County







# Population Change: 2010-2016







### Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2012-2016 5 Yr. Avg. – American Community Survey




Percent of Persons Age 25+

### Selected Public School Statistics School Year 2016-17










### Personal Current Transfer Receipts: 2016 Washington Co. Total = \$200,373,000

# Transfer Receipts as a Percentage of Total Personal Income 2010-2016






### Civilian Labor Force Average Annual Unemployment Rates



### Components of 2017 Property Tax Gross Digest Washington County





### 1% Sales & Use Tax Distributions: 2016 Washington Co. Total = \$2,314,172


